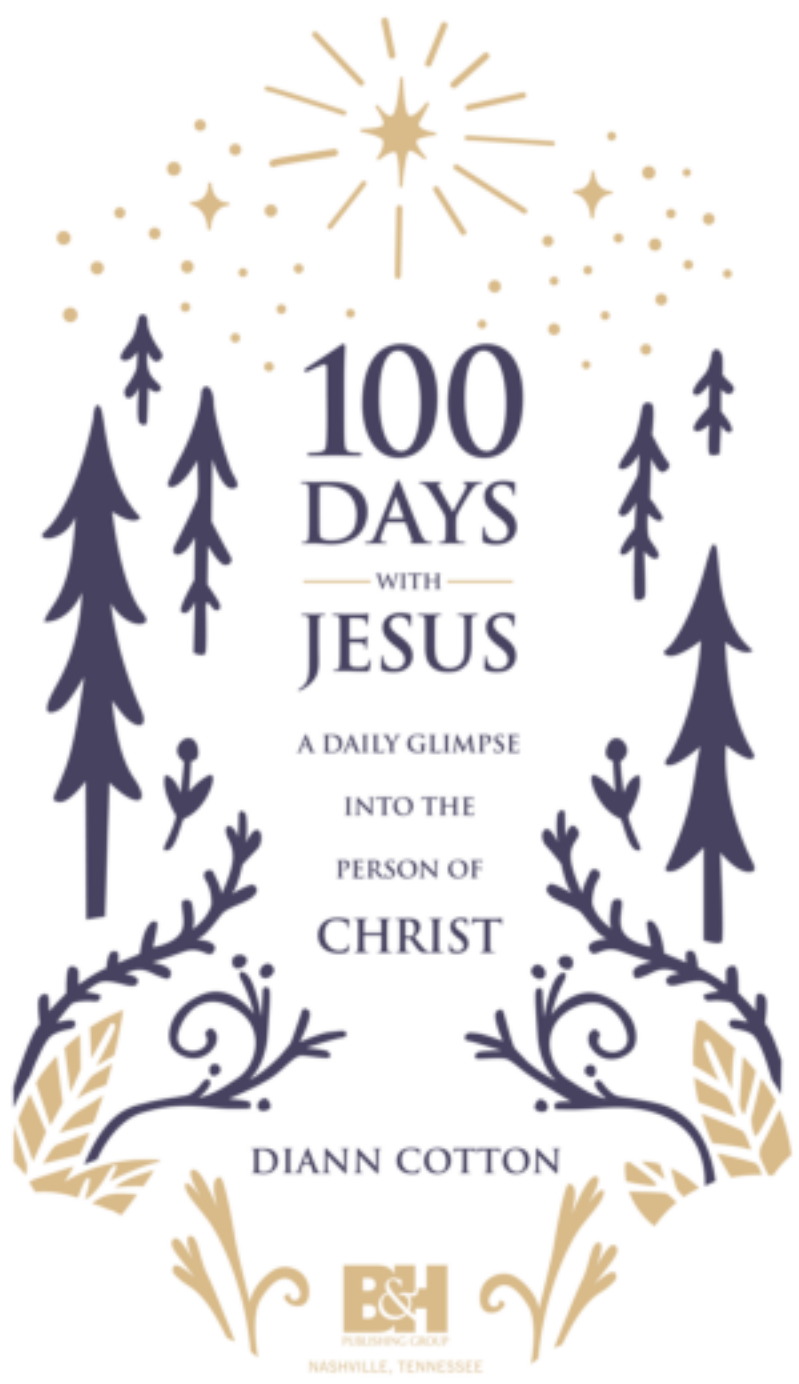

INTRODUCTION

Several years ago, I came across a page in my Bible with over 250 names for Jesus. I was in awe, and wanted to do something to display His names. In 2014, my daughter found some bells from India and we began to write the names of Jesus on them for our Christmas tree. I could envision a tree filled with only the names that describe Jesus.

On January 4, 2015, as I was putting away the bells, I realized I didn't really know what each name meant. Right then, I decided to study a different name for Jesus every day for the next year. It was my hope and desire to know Jesus better by the following Christmas. Beginning in January, I studied 2 or 3 names a week. But as I studied His names, it was not what I expected or planned. This journey would literally change my life.

Originally, I thought they would be beautiful names that were somehow applicable to my life. I didn't realize each and every name points to the gospel. They describe His central purpose—to die and pay for our sins so that we might have a forever relationship with God.

The more I understood the reality of who Jesus is, the more astounded I became. Each day built upon another. It culminated in me face down on my floor worshiping Him. If we ever needed Jesus, it is now!

Please come along with me for the next 100 days as we walk through the names that describe Jesus. Each day you'll look at Jesus through the lens of descriptive names and words. The verse where the name is found along with a simple dictionary definition will set up the prayer of response. Each day ends with a reflective question to ask yourself as you worship Jesus for who He is.

My prayer for you is that you will worship Him as never before and that you will gain a glimpse of His glory and His majesty!



DAY ONE
ADVOCATE

My little children, I am writing these things to you so that you may not sin. But if anyone does sin, we have an ADVOCATE with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous. He is the propitiation for our sins, and not for ours only but also for the sins of the whole world.

1 John 2:1–2

DEFINITION OF **ADVOCATE**: One that pleads the cause of another; specifically: one that pleads the cause of another before a tribunal or judicial court; one that defends or maintains a cause or proposal; one that supports or promotes the interests of another

Jesus, You are my **ADVOCATE**. You are the One who pleads the cause of another. Because of You, I do not have to go before God to plead my own case. You already went on my behalf. You are the propitiation (atoning sacrifice) for my sins. You paid the debt for my sins and Your sacrifice is offered to the whole world. You paid the debt that I could never pay. This is a free gift to me—but it cost You Your life. I am found not guilty because of You! Thank you, Jesus, for dying on the cross to pay for my sins! Thank You for Your great love. I worship You today for being my **ADVOCATE**!

DAY TWO
ALMIGHTY

Behold, he is coming with the clouds, and every eye will see him, even those who pierced him, and all tribes of the earth will wail on account of him. Even so. Amen. "I am the Alpha and the Omega," says the Lord God, "who is and who was and who is to come, the ALMIGHTY." Revelation 1:7-8

DEFINITION OF **ALMIGHTY**: Often capitalized: having absolute power over all; relatively unlimited in power; having or regarded as having great power or importance

Jesus, You are ALMIGHTY. One day You will ride in on the clouds and every eye will be on You. Those who did not believe in You and who wanted to destroy You, will mourn when they see who You really are. You have absolute power over all; You are unlimited in power and importance. You are complete, absolute, and have unlimited power over all. You are the ALMIGHTY—the One who is, and who was, and who is to come! Because You are ALMIGHTY, I can trust You completely with my life and with our world. Jesus, You alone are worthy of my worship! You are the ALMIGHTY!

DAY THREE

ALPHA AND THE OMEGA

And He who was seated on the throne said, “Behold, I am making all things new.” Also He said, “Write this down, for these words are trustworthy and true.” And He said to me, “It is done! I am the ALPHA AND THE OMEGA, the beginning and the end. To the thirsty I will give from the spring of the water of life without payment.” Revelation 21:5–6

DEFINITION OF **ALPHA**: The 1st letter of the Greek alphabet; something that is first: beginning

DEFINITION OF **OMEGA**: The 24th and last letter of the Greek alphabet: the extreme or final part: end

Jesus, You are the ALPHA AND THE OMEGA. You were here in the beginning, and You will be here in the end. One day You will bring in the new heaven and the new earth.

You will wipe away every tear from my eyes, and there will be no more death or mourning, crying or pain. This is Your gift, without payment from me. But it was not free for You. It cost You Your life. You paid my debt on the cross and offered me the free gift of life with You. I am amazed that You would die for me. DAY FOUR
AMEN

And to the angel of the church in Laodicea write: “The words of the AMEN, the faithful and true witness, the beginning of God’s creation. I know your works: you are neither cold nor hot. Would that you were either cold or hot! So, because you are lukewarm, and neither hot nor cold, I will spit you out of my mouth. For you say, I am rich, I have prospered, and I need nothing, not realizing that you are wretched, pitiable, poor, blind, and naked.” Revelation 3:14–17

DEFINITION OF AMEN: So be it; truth, firmness, trust, confidence, fixed, sure

Jesus, You are the AMEN. So be it. Truth. Firmness. Trust. Confidence. Fixed. Sure. You are the faithful and true witness, and the beginning of God’s creation. You know my heart. You know that I want to depend on the things of this world for my worth—but I am wretched, poor, pitiable, blind and naked without You. You long for me to be zealous in my love for You. You have clothed me with Your white garment through Your payment for my sin on the cross. You want a close personal relationship with me. Thank You Jesus for trading my sin for Your white garment. You are the AMEN—fixed and true. Jesus, give me a zealous heart for You today. Stir my affection and open my eyes that I may see You for who You are! I worship You, the AMEN!

In what ways are you lukewarm toward Jesus? Thank Him, praise Him, and worship Him as the AMEN today!!



DAY FIVE

AUTHOR AND PERFECTER OF FAITH

And let us run with endurance the race set before us, fixing our eyes on Jesus, the AUTHOR AND PERFECTER OF FAITH, who for the joy set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and has sat down at the right hand of the throne of God. Hebrews 12:1b-2 (NASB)

DEFINITION OF **AUTHOR**: One that originates or creates

DEFINITION OF **PERFECTER**: To bring to final form; to make perfect: improve, refine

Jesus, You are the **AUTHOR AND PERFECTER OF FAITH**. You are the **AUTHOR**—the originator of those who believe. And You are the **PERFECTER**—the One who will complete, finalize, improve, and refine my faith. Jesus, You suffered and despised the shame as You endured the cross, but You did it for the joy that was set before You. I want to run my race with endurance, casting aside every sin that holds me back, and I want to fix my eyes on You, the **AUTHOR AND PERFECTER OF FAITH**. Remind me to consider the hostility You endured by sinners for my sake, so that I will not grow weary and lose heart. You are the One who began my faith and will complete it. I want to fix my eyes on **YOU**, the **AUTHOR AND PERFECTER OF FAITH**!

DAY SIX
BABY

And this will be a sign for you; you will find a BABY wrapped in swaddling cloths and lying in a manger. And suddenly there was with the angel a multitude of the heavenly host praising God and saying, “Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace among those with whom He is pleased!” Luke 2:12–14

DEFINITION OF **BABY**: An extremely young child; especially: infant

Jesus, the Almighty, King of Kings came to earth as an infant BABY for one purpose—to give His life for me and for all people. This was the good news of great joy that the angels told the shepherds. The angel also said to the shepherds “and on earth peace among men with whom He is pleased!” Jesus, You are pleased with me. You love me so much that You left Your glorious throne in heaven, to enter a broken world and become a human BABY. To be born in a feeding trough with animals in a barn. How can this be? The Savior of the world, the Majestic and Holy King, came to earth as a BABY. Thank you Jesus for coming to earth and being born in a manger to die for my sins that I might live forever with You! 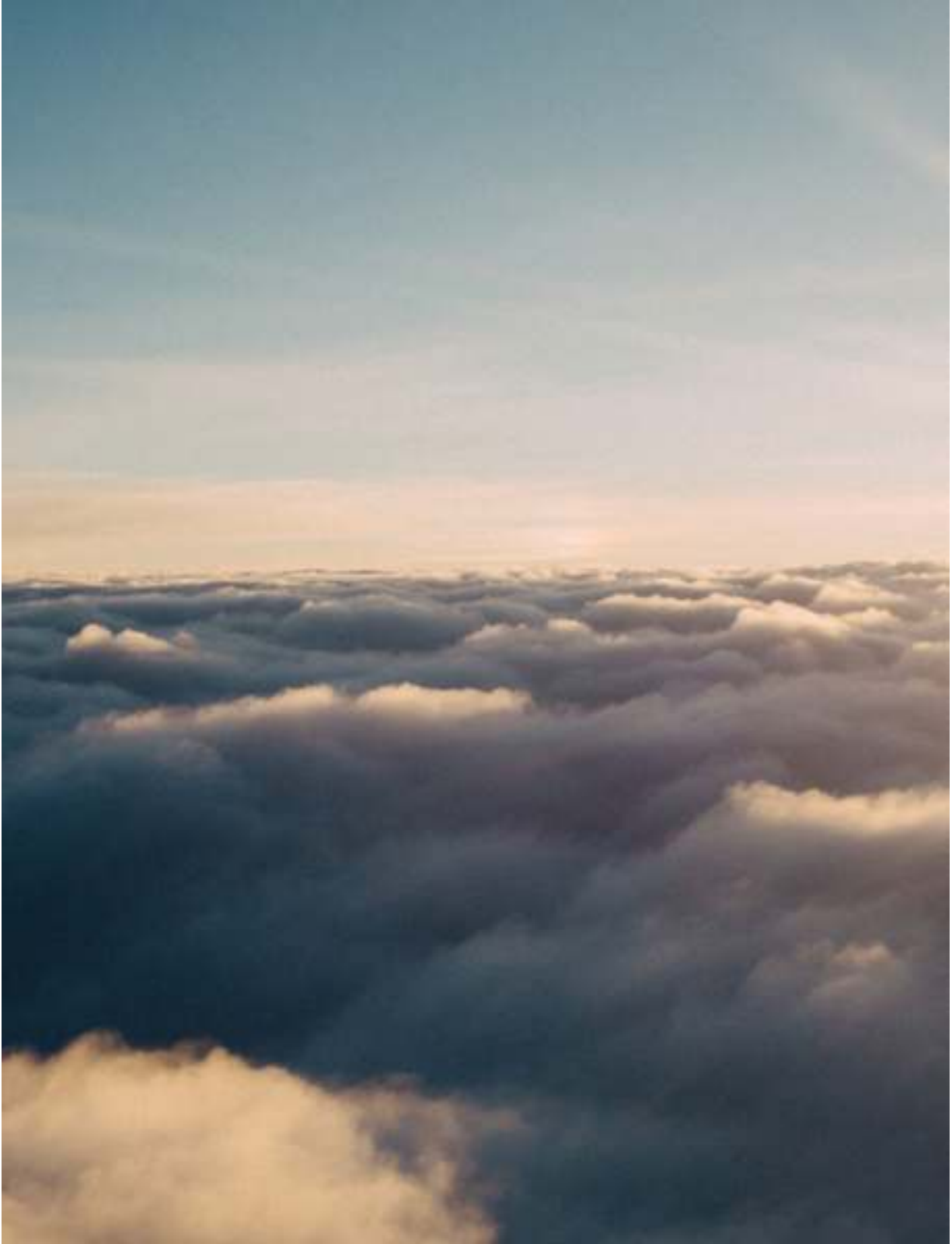
DAY SEVEN
BELOVED SON

In those days Jesus came from Nazareth of Galilee and was baptized by John in the Jordan. And when He came up out of the water, immediately He saw the heavens being torn open and the Spirit descending on Him like a dove. And a voice came from heaven, "You are My BELOVED SON; with You I am well pleased." Mark 1:9–11

DEFINITION OF **BELOVED**: Dearly loved; dear to the heart; very much loved

Jesus is the BELOVED SON of God the Father. He is very much loved, dearly loved, and dear to the heart of God the Father. As Jesus is baptized, God the Father's voice confirms His love for His Son, as the Holy Spirit descends on Him like a dove. God the Father declares that Jesus is His BELOVED SON and that He is well pleased. John 3:16 says, "For God so loved the world that He gave His only Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have eternal life." It is because of God the Father's love for me that He gave His only son, His BELOVED SON, that I might have eternal life through Him. I thank You and praise You, God, for giving Your only Son—Your BELOVED SON—that I might believe and have eternal life through Him. This was Your plan. Jesus' purpose when He came to earth was to live and die for me. I worship and adore You today Jesus, BELOVED SON, for giving Your life for me!

DAY EIGHT

BLESSED AND ONLY SOVEREIGN

I charge you in the presence of God, who gives life to all things, and of Christ Jesus, who testified before Pontius Pilate, that you keep the commandment without stain or reproach until the appearing of our Lord Jesus Christ, which He will bring about at the proper time—He who is the BLESSED AND ONLY SOVEREIGN, the King of Kings and Lord of Lords; who alone possesses immortality and dwells in unapproachable light; whom no man has seen or can see. To Him be honor and eternal dominion! Amen. 1 Timothy 6:13–16 (NASB)

DEFINITION OF **BLESSED**: Having a sacred nature: Held in reverence: venerated: honored in worship: hallowed

DEFINITION OF **SOVEREIGN**: One possessing or held to possess supreme political power or sovereignty; King or Queen

Jesus, You are the BLESSED—sacred, held in reverence, honored in worship—and ONLY SOVEREIGN—one who is King and holds supreme power. I revere You, I worship You, and I bow before You, King Jesus. You are to be honored in worship as the Supreme power who has an unending existence and lasting fame. Jesus, because of who You are, I want to fight the good fight of faith, and take hold of the eternal life to which You have called me. One day You will appear and I will see You face to face. Your glory will be more than I can describe. Oh Jesus, let me see You today for who You are. You are the BLESSED AND ONLY SOVEREIGN. I worship You with my life and my all!

DAY NINE
BREAD OF LIFE

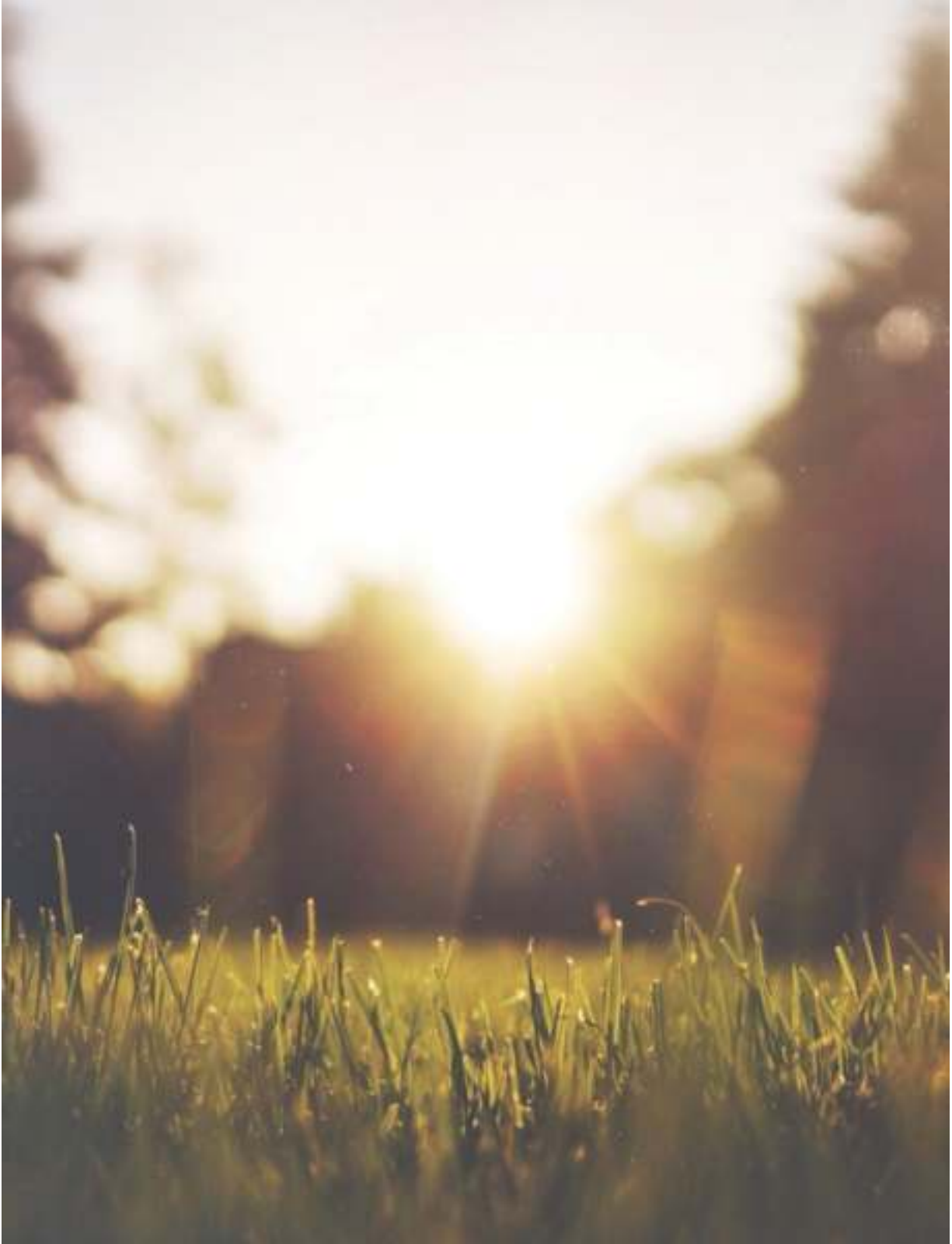

DAY TEN
BRIDEGROOM

“The one who has the bride is the BRIDEGROOM. The friend of the BRIDEGROOM, who stands and hears him, rejoices greatly at the BRIDEGROOM’s voice. Therefore this joy of mine is now complete. He must increase, but I must decrease.” John 3:29–30

And Jesus said to them, “Can the wedding guests fast while the BRIDEGROOM is with them? As long as they have the BRIDEGROOM with them, they cannot fast. The days will come when the BRIDEGROOM is taken away from them, and then they will fast in that day.” Mark 2:19–20

DEFINITION OF **BRIDEGROOM**: A man just married or about to be married

DAY ELEVEN

BRIGHT MORNING STAR

“I, Jesus, have sent My angel to testify to you these things for the churches, I am the root and the offspring of David, the BRIGHT MORNING STAR. The Spirit and the bride say, ‘Come.’ And let the one who hears say, ‘Come.’ And let the one who is thirsty come; let the one who desires take the water of life without price.”

Revelation 22:16–17

DEFINITION OF **MORNING STAR**: A bright planet (as Venus) seen in the eastern sky before or at sunrise

Jesus, You are the BRIGHT MORNING STAR. The appearance of the MORNING STAR signals that morning is about to dawn into the darkness of the night and a new day is coming. A new day is coming when You will come again and make all things right. You are coming again just as You came before! You will come and call all who are thirsty to You. You will make all things right—there will be no more tears, sadness, pain, or death. I will never again experience fear or sorrow (Rev. 21:4). Because You are the BRIGHT MORNING STAR, I have great hope in the day You will make all things new! Jesus, I thank You and worship You for being the BRIGHT MORNING STAR!

What does it mean to you today that you can look to Jesus as the BRIGHT MORNING STAR? Thank Him, praise Him, and worship Him as the BRIGHT MORNING STAR today!!



DAY TWELVE
CARPENTER

Is not this the CARPENTER, the son of Mary, and brother of James and Joses and Judas and Simon? Are not His sisters here with us? And they took offense at Him. And Jesus said to them, "A prophet is not without honor, except in his hometown and among his relatives and in his own household." And He could do no mighty work there, except that He laid His hands on a few sick people and healed them. Mark 6:3–5

DEFINITION OF CARPENTER: A worker who builds or repairs wooden structures or their structural parts

Jesus, You grew up and became a CARPENTER in Nazareth. You had brothers and sisters. You were fully man, yet You were fully God. The people in your hometown were so accustomed to Your name, that they couldn't see who You really were. They were looking at You through the world's eyes as a simple CARPENTER. But You were so much more than a CARPENTER! You were the KING OF KINGS AND LORD OF LORDS! You marveled at their unbelief. Those who knew You and could have trusted You by seeing even the few sick people you healed, didn't believe or see You for who You are. They missed all that You could have done for them. Jesus, I have heard Your name all my life, but I don't fully know who You are. Oh Jesus, don't let me miss You. Open my eyes to see Your majesty and Your power. Don't let my unbelief keep me from trusting You for all that You want to do on this earth! Increase my affection for You and open my eyes to see Your majesty and Your power! DAY THIRTEEN
CHOSEN ONE

And as the men were parting from Him, Peter said to Jesus, “Master, it is good that we are here. Let us make three tents, one for You and one for Moses and one for Elijah”—not knowing what he said. As he was saying these things, a cloud came and overshadowed them, and they were afraid as they entered the cloud. And a voice came out of the cloud, saying “This is My Son, My CHOSEN ONE, listen to Him!” Luke 9:33–35

DEFINITION OF **CHOSEN**: One who is the object of choice or of divine favor: an elect person: selected to do or receive something special

Jesus, You are the CHOSEN ONE. You are not equal to Moses and Elijah. You are far greater! You are God’s Son—the CHOSEN ONE! CHOSEN to fulfill every Law and the Prophets. CHOSEN to pay the debt that I owe. CHOSEN to conquer death and the grave. CHOSEN to ascend from the earth and to sit at the right hand of God the Father for all eternity! When the cloud came and overshadowed them and they were afraid as they entered the cloud, God the Father spoke, “This is my Son, my CHOSEN ONE, listen to Him!” It is all about You, JESUS. It is not about any created person or thing. It is all about You. You are the CHOSEN ONE and deserve all my worship, all my attention and all my praise! I worship You Jesus. I bow before You, the CHOSEN ONE!

DAY FOURTEEN

CHRIST

Therefore, if anyone is in CHRIST, he is a new creation. The old has passed away; behold, the new has come. All this is from God, who through CHRIST reconciled us to Himself and gave us the ministry of reconciliation, that is, in CHRIST God was reconciling the world to Himself, not counting their trespasses against them, and entrusting to us the message of reconciliation. 2 Corinthians 5:17–19

DEFINITION OF **CHRIST**: Messiah (a king who will be sent by God to save the Jews): Jesus Christ: a person who is expected to save people from a very bad situation

Jesus, You are the CHRIST, the Messiah sent to reconcile me to God. You came to earth knowing that You would be the substitutionary payment for my sin. You who were sinless, would take on my sin—my shame and my guilt—to pay the penalty for my sin. You were stripped of Your clothes, beaten, and killed for me. Jesus, I have done NOTHING to deserve this. I can do NOTHING to earn it. Because I have believed what You have done for me, I am now reconciled to God through You. I stand before You holy and blameless now and forevermore (Eph. 1:4). You loved me so much that You gave your life for me. Because of this, I am a new creation! The old has passed, the new has come!!! These words feel so small in comparison to what You have done for me, but I worship You and thank You, Jesus, for loving me so much that You would substitute Your sinless life for mine. I give You my life and my all!

What does it mean to you that Jesus would substitute His life for yours? Thank Him, praise Him, and worship Him as your CHRIST today!!



DAY FIFTEEN
CHRIST JESUS

Who shall bring any charge against God's elect? It is God who justifies. Who is to condemn? CHRIST JESUS is the One who died—more than that, who was raised—who is at the right hand of God, who indeed is interceding for us. Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? Shall tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or danger, or sword? As it is written, "For your sake we are being killed all the day long; we are regarded as sheep to be slaughtered." No, in all these things we are more than conquerors through Him who loved us. Romans 8:31–39

DEFINITION OF **CHRIST**: Messiah: Jesus

DEFINITION OF **JESUS**: The Jewish religious teacher whose life, death, and resurrection are the basis of the Christian message of salvation

Jesus, You are **CHRIST JESUS**—the Messiah whose life, death, and resurrection are the foundation of our faith! God, You did not even spare Your own Son. I can trust You to graciously give me what I need! Jesus, You are sitting at God's right hand interceding for me! Nothing shall separate me from Your love, Jesus! Nothing in this world: not death, not rulers, not things that I fear in the future nor things that I fear in the present. **NOTHING** can separate me from the love of **CHRIST JESUS!!!** God, You are **FOR** me—You did not spare Your own Son—but gave Him up for me. I worship You, I adore You, Jesus—**NOTHING** can separate me from Your love, **CHRIST JESUS!!**

*What do you feel is separating you from the love of **CHRIST JESUS** today? Thank Him, praise Him, and worship Him as **CHRIST JESUS** today!!*



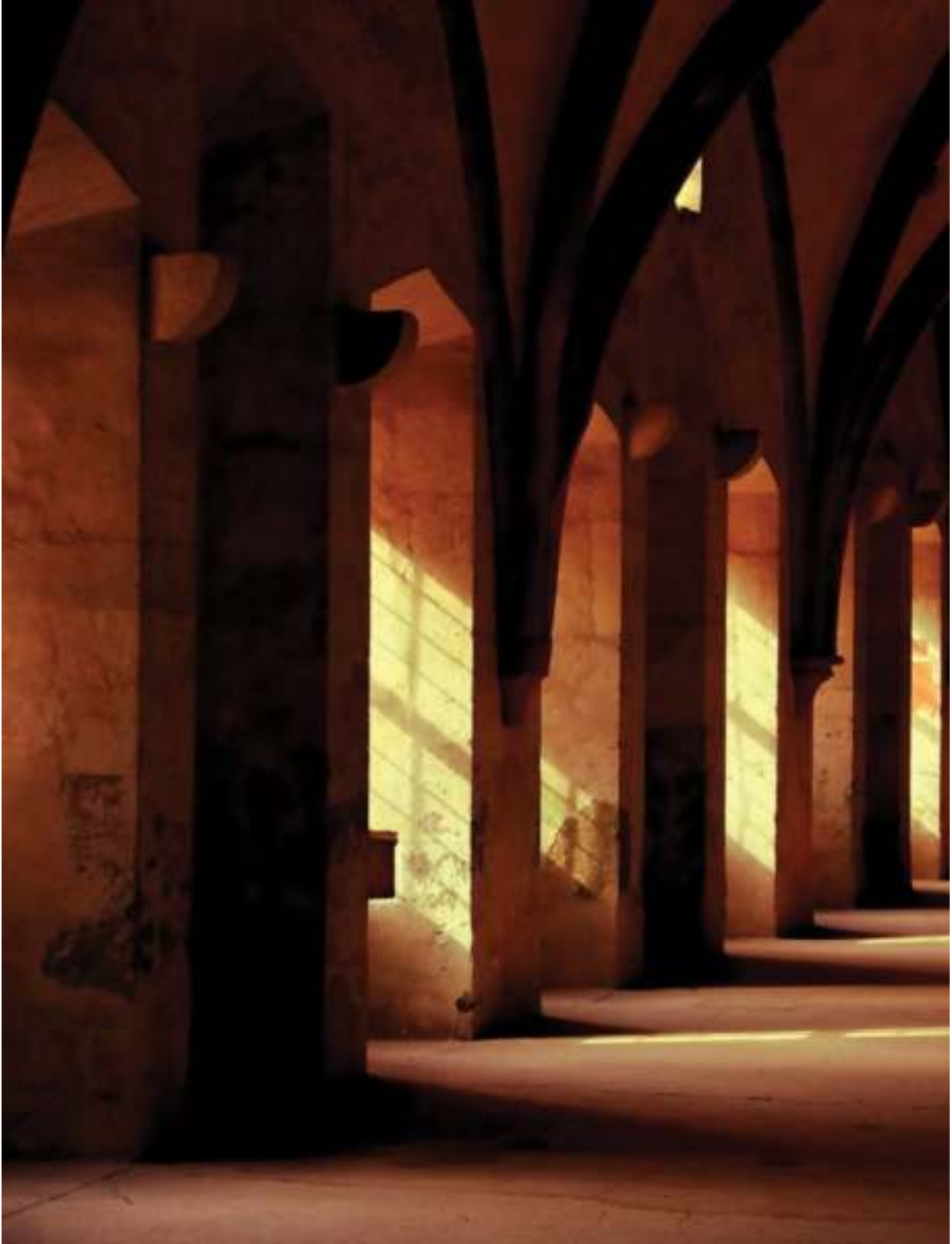
DAY SIXTEEN
CONSOLATION

There was a man in Jerusalem whose name was Simeon. This man was righteous and devout, looking forward to Israel's CONSOLATION, and the Holy Spirit was on him. It had been revealed to him by the Holy Spirit that he would not see death before he saw the Lord's Messiah. Guided by the Spirit, he entered the temple complex. When the parents brought in the child Jesus to perform for Him what was customary under the law, Simeon took Him up in his arms, praised God, and said, "Now, Master, You can dismiss Your slave in peace, as You promised. For my eyes have seen Your salvation." Luke 2:25–30 (HCSB)

DEFINITION OF **CONSOLATION**: The act or an instance of consoling; the state of being consoled: comfort

Jesus, You are the CONSOLATION of this broken world. You are comfort, reassurance, and solace. Simeon waited his whole life to see the One who would rescue and comfort his people. When he realized You were the One, he had complete peace. He knew that You were the only answer to this broken world and that You had come. You are the hope for everything I encounter here on this earth and You have promised me eternal life with You. Jesus, You came to earth as the answer to every problem I face. You came to provide a way for me and for all the world to know You. To what am I looking besides You as the CONSOLATION and comfort of my life? May I look and wait only for You as my CONSOLATION now and for all eternity! I worship You and thank You, Jesus, for being my CONSOLATION!!

To what are you looking for CONSOLATION and comfort? Thank Him, praise Him, and worship Him as your CONSOLATION today!!



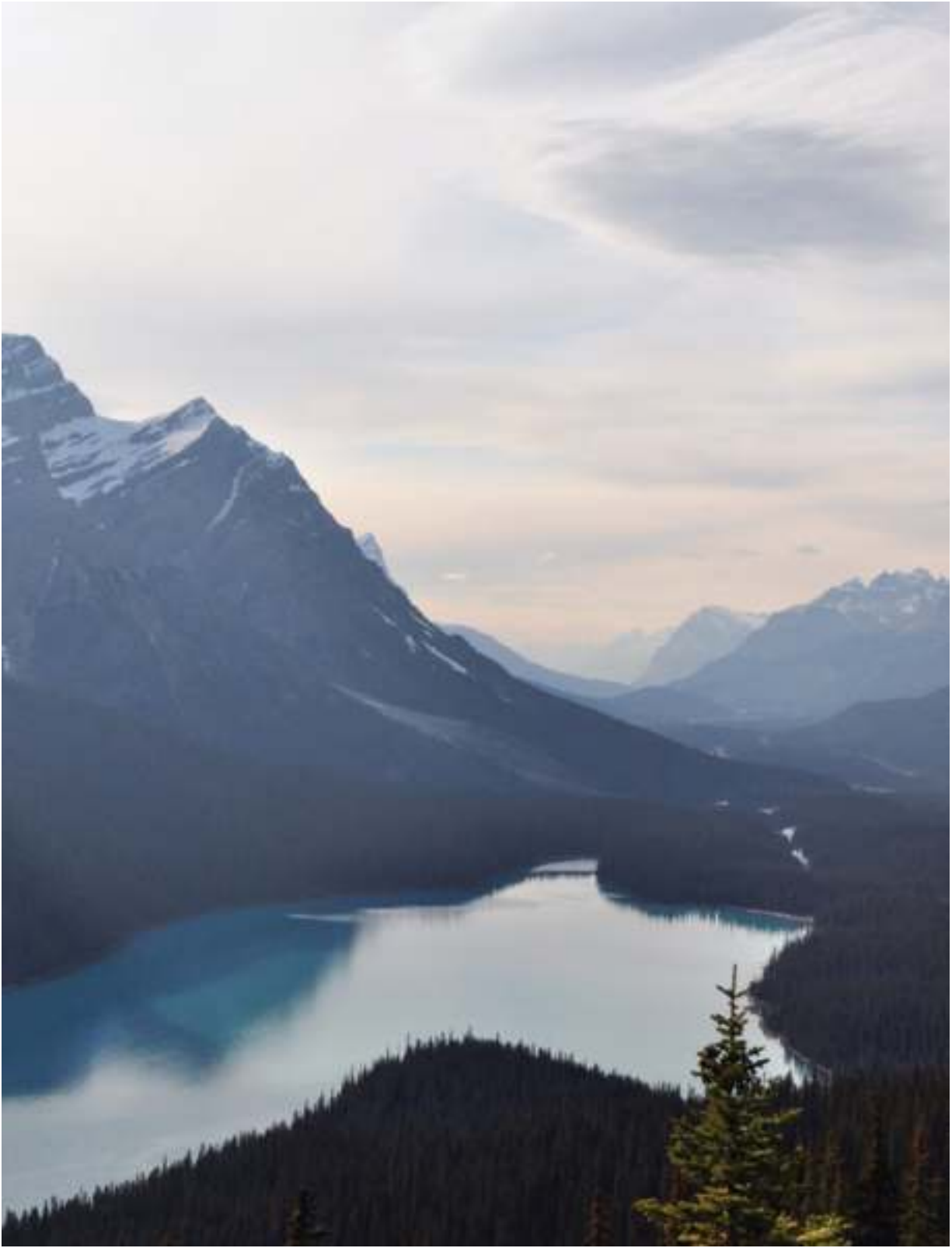
DAY SEVENTEEN
CORNERSTONE

Then Peter, filled with the Holy Spirit, said to them, “Rulers of the people and elders, if we are being examined today concerning a good deed done to a crippled man, by what means this man has been healed, let it be known to all of you and to all the people of Israel that by the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, whom you crucified, whom God raised from the dead—by Him this man is standing before you well. This Jesus is the stone that was rejected by you, the builders, which has become the CORNERSTONE. And there is salvation in no one else, for there is no other name under heaven given among men by which we must be saved.” Acts 4:8–12

DEFINITION OF CORNERSTONE: A stone uniting two masonry walls at an intersection: something that is essential, indispensable, or basic, true: the chief foundation on which something is constructed or developed

Jesus, You are the CORNERSTONE. You are essential, indispensable, basic, and true. You provide the true and accurate foundation for my life and my faith. You were rejected by the religious leaders of Your day because You were not who they envisioned as the Messiah. But You, the CORNERSTONE, are the One who has provided salvation for all of mankind. DEFINITION OF **DEITY**: Divine character or nature, especially that of the Supreme Being; divinity: One exalted or revered as supremely good or powerful

Jesus, You are DEITY. You are the Supreme Being, exalted and revered as supremely good and powerful. The completeness of God was present in your earthly body. Everything that God is, You are. You are our Creator, You know everything, You are everywhere at all times. You have all power and You rule over everything. You hold the ultimate authority. DEFINITION OF **DELIVER**: To set free: to take (something) to a person or place

Jesus, You are my DELIVERER! You are the One who rescues and releases me from this broken world now and forever! Jesus, You gave Yourself for my sins. You chose to come to earth to give Yourself for me so that I might be DELIVERED from this present evil age to Your kingdom. I want to be moved by what You have done for me. DAY TWENTY

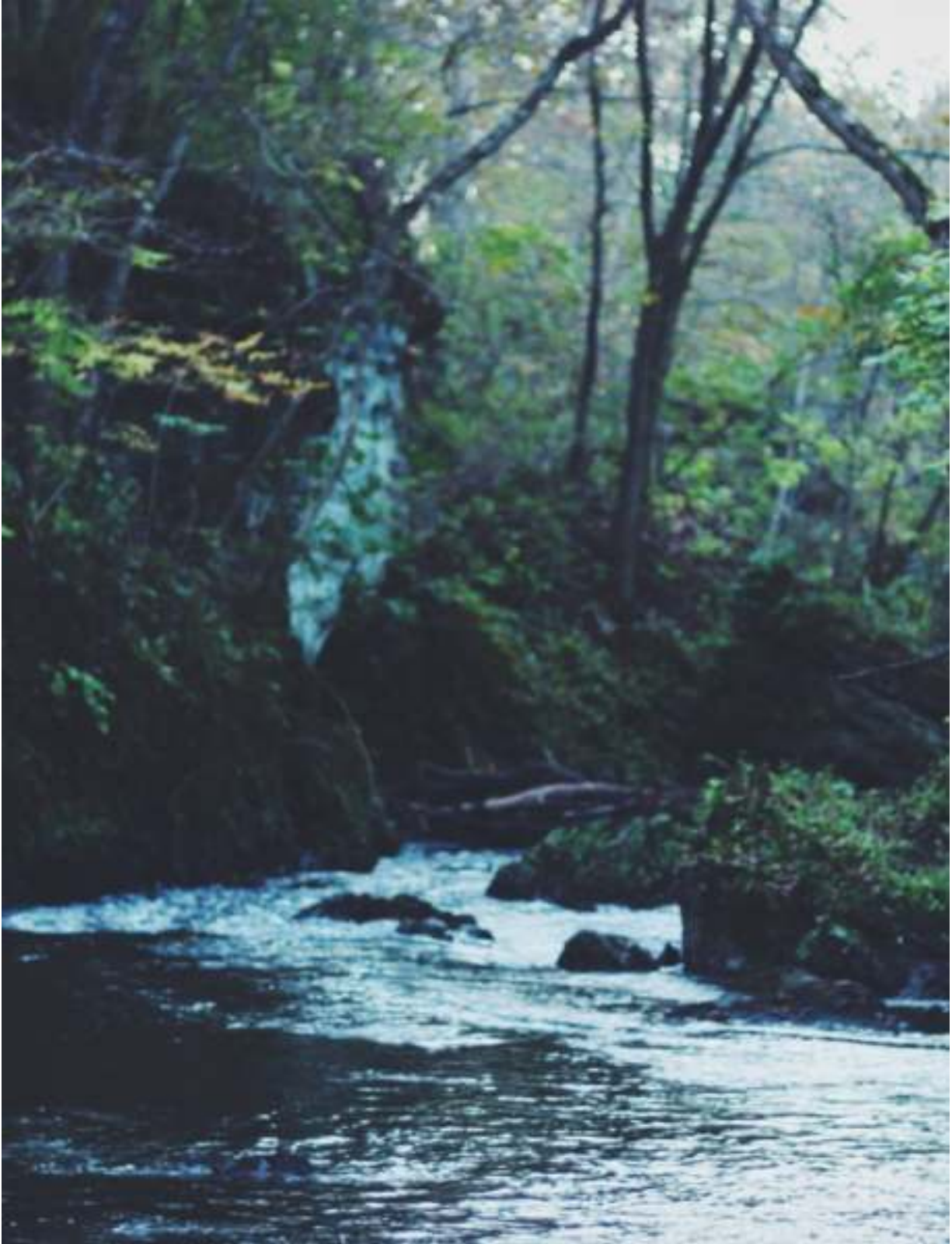
DOOR

So Jesus again said to them, “Truly, truly, I say to you, I am the DOOR of the sheep. All who came before Me are thieves and robbers, but the sheep did not listen to them. I am the DOOR. DEFINITION OF **DOOR**: A usually swinging or sliding barrier by which an entry is closed and opened; A means of access

DAY TWENTY-ONE

DEFINITION OF ETERNAL: Having infinite duration: everlasting: having no beginning and no end in time: lasting forever: continued without intermission: perpetual: valid or existing at all times: timeless

Jesus, You are ageless, dateless, enduring, and everlasting; alive for eternity before this life and beyond this life. You always have been and You always will be. ETERNAL LIFE is not just a place, it is You. My mind can't comprehend it, but this is who You are. You were here in the beginning (John 1:1–3) and You will exist forever (1 John 5:11). You are the true God and ETERNAL LIFE!!! I bow before You Jesus—You are higher and greater than anything my mind can comprehend. DEFINITION OF **EXACT**: Fully and completely correct or accurate

DEFINITION OF **REPRESENTATION**: The action or fact of one person standing for another so as to have the rights and obligations of the person represented: to serve as the counterpart or image of

Jesus, You are the EXACT REPRESENTATION of God the Father. If I want to know who God is, I am to look at the Your life as You walked on this earth. Jesus, I want to know You, study You and learn more about You. You are the EXACT REPRESENTATION of God. You are the One who made the world, You are the heir of all things and You uphold all things by the word of Your power. Your purpose was to purify me of my sins, and afterward You sat down at the right hand of God the Father, the Majesty on high, where You have equal honor and equal dignity. I worship You, Jesus, for coming to earth as a man to be the EXACT REPRESENTATION of God!!

DAY TWENTY-THREE
EXPECTED ONE

Now when John, while imprisoned, heard of the works of Christ, he sent word by his disciples and said to Him, “Are You the EXPECTED ONE, or shall we look for someone else?” Jesus answered and said to them, “Go and report to John what you hear and see: the blind receive sight, and the lame walk, the lepers are cleansed and the deaf hear, the dead are raised up, and the poor have the gospel preached to them.” Matthew 11:2–5 (NASB)

DEFINITION OF EXPECT: To anticipate or look forward to the coming or occurrence of: await

Jesus, You are the EXPECTED ONE whom John the Baptist had preached would come. He even baptized You as the EXPECTED ONE, but he was imprisoned and began to doubt. Jesus, when I see tragedy and things that don't line up with who I expect You to be, I can be filled with doubt. But Your Word shows us You are the One who gave sight to the blind and made the lame walk and healed the lepers and made people hear and raised the dead and preached hope through the gospel to the poor! You were patient with John with gentle reminders of all that You had done. You pointed him to Yourself. You are the proof of who You are. Your plan was far greater than the Jews could have hoped or imagined; a plan to provide salvation and freedom to the whole world forever and ever!! You are always MORE than I expect. DAY TWENTY-FOUR

DEFINITION OF FAITHFUL: Deserving trust: keeping your promises or doing what you are supposed to do: true: just: certain: worthy to be believed: loyal: conscientious

DEFINITION OF TRUE: Steadfast, loyal: honest, just: truthful: ideal, essential: consistent: legitimate, rightful: accurate

Jesus, You came first as an infant to live among us, humble and poor. The next time, You will come on a white horse, mighty and powerful, to wage war against the forces of evil!! Your name is FAITHFUL—loyal, promise keeper, steadfast, and worthy to be believed; and TRUE—accurate, steadfast, genuine, honest, right, and authentic. You, Jesus, are FAITHFUL AND TRUE!! DAY TWENTY-FIVE

FRIEND

*Greater love has no one than this, that one lay down his life for his
FRIENDS. John 15:13 (NASB)*

DEFINITION OF **FRIEND**: One attached to another by affection or esteem

Jesus, You are my FRIEND. You say that there is no amount of love that is greater than the love a person has when he gives away his life for another. You are telling me that You love me in the same way I immediately loved my children without them doing anything to deserve it. You love me so much that You gave Your life away for me. DAY TWENTY-SIX

GENTLE

“Take my yoke upon you, and learn from me, for I am GENTLE and lowly in heart, and you will find rest for your souls.” Matthew 11:29

DEFINITION OF GENTLE: Having or showing a kind nature; not harsh or violent; not hard or forceful; not severe, rough

Jesus, You are GENTLE. You were strong but never harsh. You spoke with authority but were never severe or rough. You were kind—but always truthful. Even when You were on trial before the government officials, Your words were gentle—not hard or forceful. Your words “Come to me” invite me to trust in You personally, not merely to believe historical facts about You. It is a personal invitation. You provide rest for me from trying to earn my way to You. You provide peace when I am weary and heavy laden with burdens that You can carry. I will find rest for my soul in You. I will find peace because of what You have already done. You provide peace through Your payment for my sins. You have already paid my debt—and all I have to do is rest in what You have already done. It is paid for—my past sins, my present sins and the sins I will commit in the future. Your yoke is easy and Your load is light (Your commandments are not burdensome—1 John 5:3). DAY TWENTY-SEVEN
GOOD TEACHER

And as he was setting out on his journey, a man ran up and knelt before him and asked him, “Good Teacher, what must I do to inherit eternal life?” And Jesus, looking at him, loved him, and said to him, “You lack one thing: go, sell all that you have and give to the poor, and you will have treasure in heaven; and come, follow me.” Mark 10:17, 21

DEFINITION OF **GOOD**: Of a favorable character or tendency, of high quality: true, honorable: virtuous, right, commendable: kind, benevolent: competent, skillful

DEFINITION OF **TEACHER**: One whose occupation is to instruct

Jesus, You are the GOOD TEACHER. You are good—You are true, honorable, competent, and skillful. You are the One who taught as no one has ever taught. The rich young ruler knew that You had something he could find in no one else. He knelt before you as if before a King. He offered his good works, keeping the rules, in order to obtain eternal life. But You wanted his heart. You wanted the thing in which he was placing his identity. The idol that he had in his life; the thing he was looking to as his Savior. When asked to walk away from the one thing he held more closely than You, he couldn't do it. What am I unwilling to give up in order to follow You more completely? DAY TWENTY-EIGHT

For the grace of God has appeared, bringing salvation to all men, instructing us to deny ungodliness and worldly desires and to live sensibly, righteously, and godly in the present age, looking for the blessed hope and the appearing of the glory of our GREAT GOD and Savior, Christ Jesus; who gave Himself for us, that He might redeem us from every lawless deed and purify Himself a people for His own possession, zealous for good deeds. Titus 2:11–14 (NASB)

DEFINITION OF GREAT: Elaborate, ample: predominant: remarkable in magnitude, degree, or effectiveness: eminent, distinguished: chief or preeminent over others: grand: markedly superior in character or quality: noble: remarkably skilled

Jesus, You are my GREAT GOD. You are elaborate, predominant, remarkable in magnitude, and superior in character and quality; noble. You have purified (cleansed from sin) my life and it should cause me to want to say no to sin and yes to godliness. Jesus, You could come back at any time, and I want to be looking and waiting for Your appearance. You are my GREAT GOD—who makes a difference in the way I live everyday, and is coming back again!! DAY TWENTY-NINE

For we do not have a HIGH PRIEST who is unable to sympathize with our weaknesses, but one who in every respect has been tempted as we are, yet without sin. Hebrews 4:14–15

DEFINITION OF HIGH PRIEST: A person who has the authority to lead or perform religious ceremonies

Jesus, You are my GREAT HIGH PRIEST; my advocate, champion, and friend. You passed through the heavens to come to earth to live as a man. Jesus, You can sympathize with my weaknesses, because You have walked this earth. You were tempted, yet You never sinned. Jesus I can come confidently, free of insecurity or fear, to Your throne of grace. Jesus, You are not a GREAT HIGH PRIEST who is unapproachable, but One who cares for my every need and longs for me to come to You. DAY THIRTY
GREAT SHEPHERD

Now may the God of peace who brought again from the dead our Lord Jesus, the GREAT SHEPARD of the sheep, by the blood of the eternal covenant, equip you with everything good that you may do his will, working in us that which is pleasing in his sight, through Jesus Christ, to whom be glory forever and ever. Amen.

DEFINITION OF **GREAT**: Remarkable in magnitude, degree, or effectiveness: eminent, distinguished: grand: markedly superior in character or quality: noble: remarkably skilled

DEFINITION OF **SHEPHERD**: To tend as a shepherd; to guide or guard in the manner of a shepherd: pastor

Jesus, You are the GREAT SHEPHERD. You are the grand and noble One who coaches, counsels, leads, mentors, guides, and shows me the way. You tenderly care for Your sheep, the people who belong to You. Jesus, You are as alive today as when You were walking on the earth. You are the GREAT SHEPHERD. And my part as one of the sheep is simply to trust and follow You. DAY THIRTY-ONE

Peter 2:25 (NASB)

DEFINITION OF **GUARDIAN**: Someone or something that watches or protects something: one that guards: one who has the care of the person or property of another

DEFINITION OF **SOUL**: The spiritual part of a person that is believed to give life to the body and is believed to live forever

Jesus, You are the GUARDIAN OF MY SOUL. You are the One who keeps, protects and watches over my soul, now and forever in eternity with you. Jesus, in order to guard my soul, You gave Your life, perfect and sinless, for me on the cross. You did not utter any threats when You were suffering under the hands of cruel men. “Like a lamb that is led to slaughter, and like a sheep that is silent before its shearers, so He did not open His mouth” (Isa. 53:7 NASB). DAY THIRTY-TWO

He is also HEAD OF THE BODY, THE CHURCH, and He is the beginning, the first-born from the dead; so that He Himself might come to have first place in everything. Colossians 1:16–18 (NASB)

DEFINITION OF **HEAD**: The place of leadership, honor, or command

DEFINITION OF **CHURCH**: The whole body of Christians

DEFINITION OF **EKKLESIA**: to call out; the called people; all who were called by and to Christ in the fellowship of His salvation, the church worldwide of all times

Jesus, You are the **HEAD**—the One who gives leadership and supplies the spiritual life to the body of believers (1 Cor. 12:27)—of the Church for all time. There is no one higher than YOU, there is no one greater than YOU. You are the **HEAD** (Eph. 1:22–23) over all things to the church. You are higher and greater than anything my heart can imagine—You are the One who created everything that exists and You are the One who holds it together. You are the One who is the **HEAD OF THE CHURCH**, and You give leadership at all times to **YOUR BODY** of believers. I bow before You Jesus, the **HEAD OF THE CHURCH!!**

DAY THIRTY-THREE

HEALER

And when Jesus entered Peter's house, He saw his mother-in-law lying sick with a fever. He touched her hand, and the fever left her, and she rose and began to serve Him. That evening they brought to Him many who were oppressed by demons, and He cast out the spirits with a word and HEALED all who were sick. Matthew 8:14–16

And He HEALED many who were sick with various diseases, and cast out many demons. And He would not permit the demons to speak, because they knew Him. Mark 1:32–34

DEFINITION OF **HEALER**: One who makes sound or whole: to restore to health: to cause (an undesirable condition) to be overcome

Jesus, You are my HEALER. You restored to health, and you overcame death! You took upon Yourself the infirmities of mankind and died on my behalf! “But He was pierced through for our transgressions, He was crushed for our iniquities; the chastening for our well-being fell upon Him, and by His scourging we are HEALED” (Isa. 53:5 NASB). Jesus, when I think of the whole city coming to Your door after dark, all who were sick and demon possessed, wanting You to heal them—I imagine it must have been overwhelming and exhausting. Yet, You patiently and compassionately healed them and took authority over the demons, even commanding them not to speak! Jesus, You have compassion for me. You gave Your life to die for my sins and You gave Your life to HEAL when You walked on this earth, patiently and compassionately caring for the sick and demon possessed. Only You have overcome death! You are my ultimate HEALER!!

DAY THIRTY-FOUR
HIS SERVANT

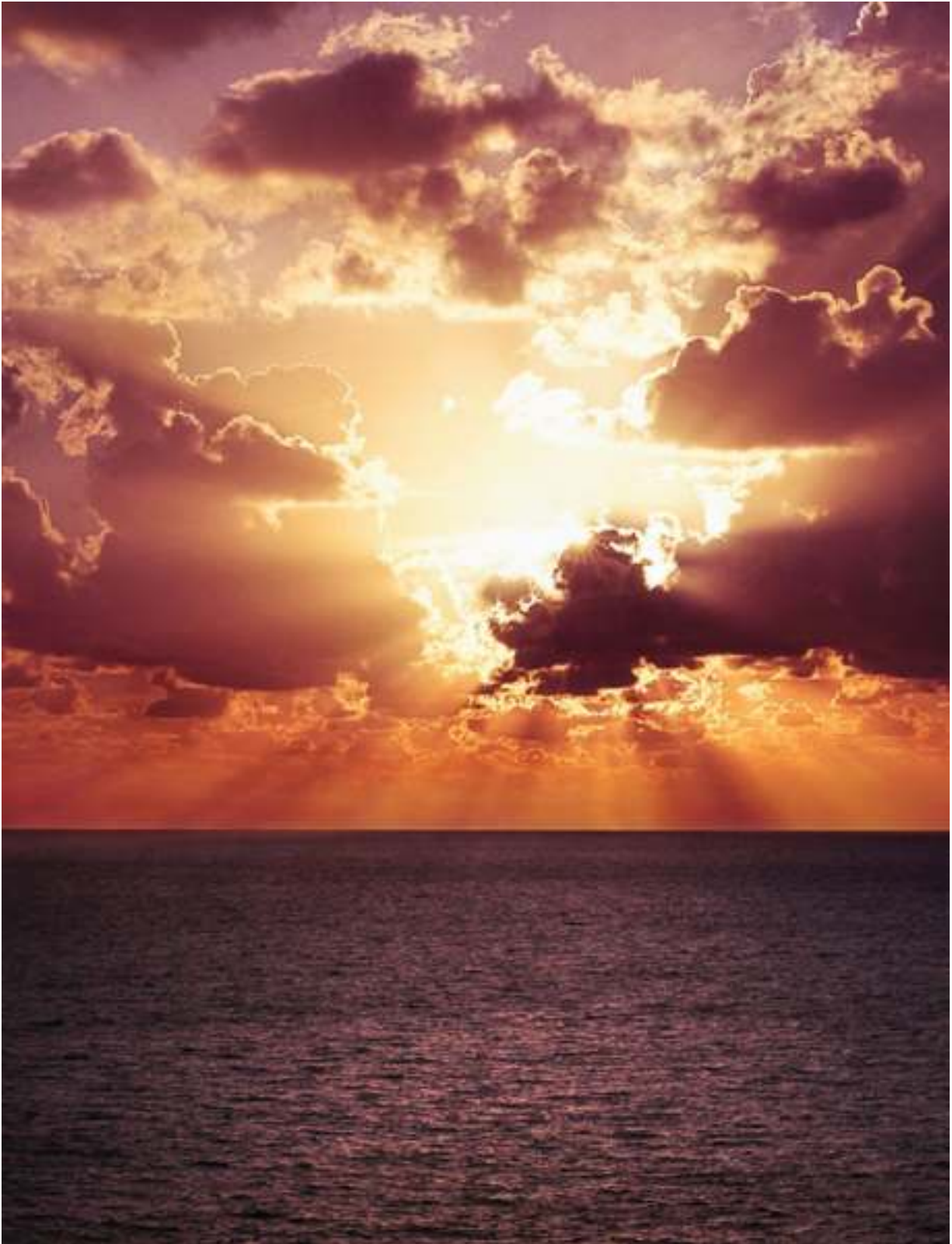
They were taking note of him as being the one who used to sit at the Beautiful Gate of the temple to beg alms, and they were filled with wonder and amazement at what had happened to him. And while he was clinging to Peter and John, all the people ran together to them at the so-called portico of Solomon, full of amazement. But when Peter saw this, he replied to the people, “Men of Israel, why are you amazed at this, or why do you gaze at us, as if by our own power or piety we had made him walk? The God of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob, the God of our fathers, has glorified HIS SERVANT Jesus, the one whom you delivered and disowned in the presence of Pilate, when he had decided to release Him.” Acts 3:10–

DEFINITION OF **SERVANT**: One that serves others: a person in the service of another.

You gave Your life as a SERVANT to pay for our sins and to give us Your righteousness. (Isa. 53:11). Jesus, thank You for coming to earth as HIS SERVANT! “Although He existed in the form of God, he did not count equality with God a thing to be grasped, but emptied himself, by taking the form of a SERVANT, being born in the likeness of men” (Phil. 2:6–7). I am blown away that You would give up Your throne in heaven to come to earth as HIS SERVANT for me. I worship and thank You Jesus—for being HIS SERVANT!!

DAY THIRTY-FIVE

But you denied the HOLY AND RIGHTEOUS ONE, and asked for a murderer to be granted to you, but put to death the Author of life, whom God raised from the dead, a fact to which we are witnesses.

Acts 3:13–14 (NASB)

DEFINITION OF **HOLY**: Exalted or worthy of complete devotion as one perfect in goodness and righteousness: divine

DEFINITION OF **RIGHTEOUS**: Acting in accord with divine or moral law: free from guilt or sin

DAY THIRTY-SIX



HOPE OF GLORY

The mystery hidden for ages and generations but now revealed to His saints. To them God chose to make known how great among the Gentiles are the riches of the glory of this mystery, which is Christ in you, the HOPE OF GLORY. Colossians 1:26–27

DEFINITION OF **HOPE**: To expect with confidence: trust, reliance: desire accompanied by expectation of or belief in fulfillment: foundation or ground of hope

DEFINITION OF **GLORY**: Praise, honor, or distinction extended by common consent: renown: worshipful praise, honor, and thanksgiving: a distinguished quality or asset: great beauty and splendor: magnificence

Jesus, You are the HOPE OF GLORY! Trust, reliance, expectation, and belief in fulfillment of Your great beauty, splendor, and magnificence. Christ in me, the HOPE OF GLORY! The ESV Study Bible says, “God Himself, in the person of Christ, will be directly and personally present in the lives of His people, and His presence assures them of a future life with Him when He returns.” Jesus, the mystery that God chose to make known, is that You live directly and personally in me and those who believe in You, and that we are assured of a future life with You. This is a mystery that people waited to know for generations, and God has revealed it to us now through Jesus. This is not a truth to be taken lightly. You live in me, and I can be assured of a future life with You!! I worship You with a thankful heart as the HOPE OF GLORY!!

DAY THIRTY-SEVEN

HUMBLE

Have this mind among yourselves, which is yours in Christ Jesus, who, though He was in the form of God, did not count equality with God a thing to be grasped, but made Himself nothing, taking on the form a servant, being born in the likeness of men. And being found in human form, He HUMBLED Himself by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross. Philippians 2:5–8

DEFINITION OF **HUMBLE**: Not proud or haughty: not arrogant or assertive: ranking low in a hierarchy or scale: insignificant, unpretentious: not thinking of yourself as better than other people

Jesus, You who are God HUMBLED Yourself. You made Yourself nothing; insignificant, low in hierarchy, not arrogant or assertive. You chose to give up Your place of equality in heaven with God to come to this broken world in the form of an infant and a servant. But not only did You leave Your place of equality with God in heaven, You HUMBLED Yourself and chose to be obedient to the point of death—death on a cross. Crucifixion is said to have caused the most prolonged suffering and physically agonizing pain of any type of execution—it was the absolute destruction of the person. The excruciating pain was magnified by the degradation and humiliation that was experienced. Jesus, this wrecks me. Your love for me and all of mankind is far more than I can comprehend. I fall on my face before You, Jesus, who HUMBLED Yourself to the point of death by crucifixion for me. This was Your plan—to give up Your life for mine. This is the ultimate sacrifice. I WORSHIP YOU, JESUS!!

What can you do today to worship Jesus—who HUMBLED Himself for you? Thank Him, praise Him, and worship Him as HUMBLE today!!



DAY THIRTY-EIGHT

I AM

So the Jews said to Him, "You are not yet fifty years old, and have you seen Abraham?" Jesus said to them, "Truly, truly, I say to you, before Abraham was, I AM." So they picked up stones to throw at Him, but Jesus hid Himself and went out of the temple. John 8:57–

59

DEFINITION OF **AM**: To be, exist, have existence or being

Jesus, You are the great I AM. You are the One who has always existed. You are equal with God. You told the Jews that You were alive before Abraham. You were claiming that You have always existed - which would make you equal with God. You were also saying that You were eternal and were the God who appeared to Moses at the burning bush (Exod. 3:14). When You made this statement the Jews knew exactly what You meant. They knew that You were claiming to be God. Because of this, they picked up stones to throw at You for blasphemy. Jesus, You spoke the truth. The truth is that You, I AM, who has existed for all time, became a man and lived on earth. You had one purpose—to pay the penalty for our sin. To redeem us back to God. The Jews did not believe that You were who You said You were. Jesus, I believe that You are God and the miracles that You performed on earth were the proof (John 10:25). You have always existed before and You will always exist in the future. The truth of this gives me great security; knowing that You have always existed and that You always will exist. Thank you for being I AM—and for coming to earth as a man to pay for my sin. I worship You Jesus for being I AM!!!

Do you believe that Jesus is the I Am? Thank Him, praise Him and worship Him as I AM today!!



DAY THIRTY-NINE
IMAGE OF GOD

In their case the god of this world has blinded the minds of the unbelievers, to keep them from seeing the light of the gospel of the glory of Christ, who is the IMAGE OF GOD. 2 Corinthians 4:4

DEFINITION OF **IMAGE**: A tangible or visual representation of something: exact likeness: semblance: incarnation

Jesus, You are the visual representation of God, the exact likeness. You are the **IMAGE OF GOD**—the incarnation (the belief in Jesus Christ as both God and a human being). Jesus, You revealed God by who You were, what You said, and what You did. Colossians 1:13–15 says, “For He rescued us from the domain of darkness, and transferred us to the kingdom of His beloved Son, in whom we have redemption, the forgiveness of sins. He is the **IMAGE** of the invisible God, the first born of all creation” (NASB). Those who knew You as You walked on earth, knew the Father. You comforted Your disciples by telling them to believe in You in the same way that they believe in God. “Let not your heart be troubled; believe in God; believe also in Me” (John 14:1), and in John 10:30, “I and the Father are one.” Thank You Jesus for coming to earth and allowing me to know the true and genuine character of God by “the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ.” So beautiful! Thank You Jesus for being the **IMAGE OF GOD**!!

DAY FORTY
IMMANUEL

All this took place to fulfill what the Lord had spoken by the prophet: “Behold, the virgin shall conceive and bear a son, and they shall call his name Immanuel” (which means, God with us).

Matthew 1:22–23

DEFINITION OF **GOD**: The perfect and all-powerful spirit or being that is worshipped as the one who created and rules the universe

DEFINITION OF **WITH**: Used to say that people or things are together in one place

DEFINITION OF **US**: People in general

Jesus, You are IMMANUEL—GOD WITH US! God and man are together in one place. You were prophesied about 700 years before in Isaiah 7:14—“Behold the virgin shall conceive and bear a son, and shall call His name Immanuel.” The angel told Joseph specifically what Your purpose would be; to save Your people from their sins. This was why You were conceived by the Holy Spirit; this was why You were born. Jesus, this is the most important moment in all of history—God coming to earth as a man. You left Your throne in heaven to live in a broken world as a man. I have heard this so many times at Christmas, that the truth of it often fails to hit me. DAY FORTY-ONE
INDESCRIBABLE GIFT

DEFINITION OF **INDESCRIBABLE**: Impossible to describe: very great or extreme: inexpressible

DEFINITION OF **GIFT**: Something voluntarily transferred by one person to another without compensation: present

Jesus You are INDESCRIBABLE!! It takes hundreds of names to even begin to describe You—and they don't even come close to expressing who You really are. We do not have enough words in any language to describe You and all You did. John felt this at the end of His Gospel when he wrote “And there are also many other things which Jesus did, which if they were written in detail, I suppose that even the world itself would not contain the books which were written” (John 21:25 NASB). It was as if he had told all that he could but then felt that he had not even come close to describing who You really were.

Jesus, You are not only INDESCRIBABLE—You are my GIFT—voluntarily transferred to another without compensation! You who are INDESCRIBABLE were given to me! You were a GIFT. “For by grace you have been saved through faith, and that not of yourselves, it is the GIFT of God; not as a result of works, that no one should boast” (Eph. 2:8–9 NASB). You who are INDESCRIBABLE were voluntarily given to me as a GIFT! That alone changes my life forever. Thank You Jesus for the INDESCRIBABLE GIFT of YOURSELF! DAY FORTY-TWO
INTERCESSOR

Therefore He is able also to save forever those who draw near to God through Him, since He always lives to make INTERCESSION for them. Hebrews 7:25 (NASB)

DEFINITION OF INTERCESSION: Prayer, petition, or entreaty in favor of another: to plead for the needs of someone else: mediate

Jesus, You live to make INTERCESSION for me! You live to pray, petition, and plead for me! You hold Your Priesthood forever—it is permanent and eternal. After You ascended to heaven, You were seated at the right hand of God to be an INTERCESSOR for me. “Christ Jesus is the One who died—more than that, who was raised—who is at the right hand of God, who indeed is INTERCEDING for us” (Rom. 8:34). Jesus, there are so many times in my life when I wander from You, rebel against you, refuse to obey You—but You never give up on me! You are always INTERCEDING for me. It says You LIVE to INTERCEDE for me! This truly blows my mind—but I know it is true because You have always run after me, and pursued me when I was not pursuing You—INTERCEDING on my behalf, even when I don’t care about You. I am never alone. I am never fighting the battle on my own. You are always praying for me; pleading for me! Oh Jesus, this is too much to comprehend; Your love for me that never stops—a love from which I can never be separated, and can never lose. Oh Jesus, cause my affections for You to increase—that I might understand with all my heart Your love for me. The thought that You LIVE to INTERCEDE for me is so comforting, and yet so powerful; knowing that You are in control, that You are at the right hand of the Father! I worship You Jesus—the One who lives to INTERCEDE for me!!

How has Jesus INTERCEDED for you? Thank Him, praise Him, and worship Him as your INTERCESSOR today!!



DAY FORTY-THREE

JESUS

Therefore God has highly exalted him and bestowed on him the NAME THAT IS ABOVE EVERY NAME, so that at the name of JESUS every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, and every tongue confess that JESUS Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father. Philippians 2:9–11

DEFINITION OF JESUS: God who saves: God is the Savior

JESUS—THE NAME ABOVE ALL NAMES!! I stand in awe of You, JESUS! The angel said You would be great and would be called the Son of the Most High! You will be given the throne of Your father David and You will reign over the house of Jacob FOREVER and Your kingdom WILL HAVE NO END!! You are not just a human being, You are a supernatural, eternal being who was born as a man. You are the only One who is worthy to be called the Son of the Most High. Your name says that You are our Savior. You don't just point to the way of salvation—You ARE salvation. You provided salvation for me through Your life and death and resurrection. You are highly exalted and given the name which is above every other name! When I hear someone use Your name, JESUS—it has POWER like no other name! Your name cannot be used without it being recognized—it is the NAME ABOVE ALL NAMES! One day EVERY KNEE WILL BOW—those in heaven and on earth and under the earth—and every tongue will confess that JESUS CHRIST is LORD!! JESUS, I bow my knee to You today in surrender and worship. JESUS, give me a glimpse of Your glory and Your majesty!! You are JESUS—the NAME ABOVE ALL NAMES!

How can you worship JESUS today? Thank Him, praise Him, and worship Him as JESUS today!!



DAY FORTY-FOUR

JUDGE

And He ordered us to preach to the people, and solemnly to testify that this is the One who has been appointed by God as JUDGE of the living and the dead. Of Him all the prophets bear witness that through His name everyone who believes in Him receives forgiveness of sins. Acts 10:42–43 (NASB)

DEFINITION OF JUDGE: One who has the power to make decision on cases brought before a court of law: one who makes a decision or judgment

Jesus You have been appointed as JUDGE—the One who makes the decision. “The Father JUDGES no one, but has given all JUDGMENT to the Son . . . Truly, truly, I say to you whoever hears My word and believes Him who sent Me has eternal life. He does not come into JUDGMENT, but has passed from death to life” (John 5:22–24). These words say that whoever believes in You receives forgiveness of sins. Peter is talking to the Gentiles and explaining who You were, how You lived, healed the demon possessed, were crucified on the cross, and rose again. Peter had seen You, and had eaten with You after You rose from the dead. Peter explains that anyone who believes in You will be forgiven of their sins. Because You died to pay for my sins and rose again, I can be released from the penalty of sin when I believe in You. It is not complicated—it only takes simple faith and belief in what You did for me. Thank You Jesus for being the JUDGE—the One who knows my heart and knows if I believe in You. I worship You Jesus, the JUDGE, the One who knows my heart!!

Have you believed in Jesus? Thank Him, praise Him, and worship Him as the JUDGE today!!



DAY FORTY-FIVE

KING

To the KING eternal, immortal, invisible, the only God, be honor and glory forever and ever. Amen. 1 Timothy 1:17 (NASB)

DEFINITION OF **KING**: A male ruler of a country who usually inherits his position and rules for life

DEFINITION OF **ETERNAL**: Having no beginning and no end in time : lasting forever

DEFINITION OF **IMMORTAL**: Not capable of dying : living forever

DEFINITION OF **INVISIBLE**: Incapable by nature of being seen

Jesus, You are KING!! At Your trial, Pilate asked You, “Are You the KING of the Jews?” You answered, “My kingdom is not of this world. If My kingdom were of this world, then My servants would be fighting, that I might not be delivered up to the Jews; but as it is, My kingdom is not of this realm.” Pilate therefore said to You, “So You are a KING?” Jesus, You answered, “You say correctly that I am a KING. For this I have been born, and for this I have come into the world, to bear witness to the truth. Everyone who is of the truth hears My voice.” Pilate said to You, “What is truth?” (John 18:33–38 NASB). Pilate knew You were a KING. He didn’t understand and even asked You twice to clarify. He knew that there was something different about You, Jesus. You are the ETERNAL, IMMORTAL, INVISIBLE, ONLY GOD. This is TRUTH. Jesus, I bow my knee before You, to worship You, KING JESUS!!

How are you worshipping the KING today? Thank Him, praise Him, and worship Him as KING JESUS today!!



DAY FORTY-SIX
KING OF KINGS

Until the appearing of our Lord Jesus Christ, which He will bring about at the proper time—He who is the blessed and only Sovereign, the KING OF KINGS and Lord of Lords; who alone possesses immortality and dwells in unapproachable light; whom no man has seen or can see. To Him be honor and eternal dominion! Amen. 1 Timothy 6:14–16 (NASB)

DEFINITION OF **KING**: A male sovereign or monarch; a man who holds by life tenure, the chief authority over a country and people.

Jesus, You are not just a KING—You are the KING OF KINGS. You are the Sovereign or Monarch over all other sovereigns and monarchs. You are more SUPERIOR than any other! Jesus, You reign over all KINGS. You don't want to just be "part" of my life—You want to be the center. You want to be the "chief authority" in my life. You want to be my everything. Because You are the KING OF KINGS, You see what is best for me. You direct me out of Your love for me. Jesus, the next time You come will be in all of Your MAJESTY—as KING OF KINGS and Lord of Lords!! Reigning over all!! I don't believe I will have to be convinced to worship You—I know I will fall down in worship before You when I see You face to face. I want You to be KING over my life today—my decisions, my attitude, my all. Jesus, I surrender to You as KING OF KINGS!!!

How is Jesus the center of your life—the KING OF KINGS, the chief authority? Thank Him, praise Him, and worship Him as the KING OF KINGS today!!



DAY FORTY-SEVEN

LAMB

The next day he saw Jesus coming to him, and said, "Behold the LAMB of God who takes away the sin of the world!" John 1:29

(NASB)

DEFINITION OF **LAMB**: A young sheep

DEFINITION OF **SACRIFICE**: The act of giving up something that you want to keep especially in order to get or do something else or to help someone

Jesus, You are the LAMB. You are the sacrifice that takes away the sin of the world. You gave Yourself as a sacrificial LAMB. All of my sin was placed on You at the cross. Long before You died You knew that You were to be the substitute. You knew that the sin of the whole world would be placed on You. You knew You would be murdered on a cross. This is why You were born. I cannot even begin to fathom what it would be like to know in advance that this was going to happen. You WERE the sacrificial LAMB. You were the lamb who was SLAIN for the world. Your love for me enabled You to endure and face the cross. The night before Your death, as You were praying, "Your sweat became like drops of blood" as You faced the reality of what would occur the next day. Jesus, You gave Your life that I might live. "He made Him who knew no sin to be sin on our behalf, that we might become the righteousness of God in Him" (2 Cor. 5:21 NASB). You are the LAMB who takes away the sin of the world! Jesus, this truth changes my life! I honor You with complete worship, thankfulness, and surrender!!

How can you honor Jesus as the LAMB today? Thank Him, praise Him, and worship Him as the LAMB today!!



DAY FORTY-EIGHT

LIFE

Let not your heart be troubled, believe in God, believe also in Me. In My Father's house are many dwelling places, if it were not so, I would have told you; for I go to prepare a place for you. And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again, and receive you to Myself; that where I am, there you may be also. And you know the way where I am going. Thomas said to Him, "Lord we do not know where You are going, how do we know the way?" Jesus said to him, "I am the way, and the truth, and the LIFE, no one comes to the Father, but through Me." John 14:1–6

DEFINITION OF LIFE: A vital or living being

Jesus, You are the LIFE. You are where LIFE is found; vital, abundant LIFE. It begins with You and will always be in You—even into eternal LIFE. LIFE begins when we come to the Father through You. Before I knew You, I was dead in my trespasses and sins in which I once walked (Eph. 2:1–2). But now You have given me LIFE. What does this mean to me? It means that You have called me to a meaningful and full LIFE—not to a miserable, lifeless existence. You have given rich, full, joyful meaning and purpose to anyone who has LIFE in You. It means that I can tell others about LIFE that is only found in You. Jesus, thank You for giving LIFE—rich, full, meaningful, abundant LIFE to those who know You! I don't want to look for LIFE in anything other than You! I worship You today, Jesus—You are the LIFE!!

Where do you look for LIFE? Thank Him, praise Him, and worship Him for being the LIFE today!!



DAY FORTY-NINE

LIGHT

In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. He was in the beginning with God. All things were made through Him, and without Him was not any thing made that was made. In Him was life, and the life was the LIGHT of men. The LIGHT shines in the darkness, and the darkness has not overcome it. John 1:1–5

Again Jesus spoke to them, saying, “I am the LIGHT of the world. Whoever follows me will not walk in darkness, but will have the LIGHT of life.” John 8:12

DEFINITION OF **LIGHT**: Something that makes vision possible: the brightness produced by the sun, by fire, a lamp

Jesus, You are LIGHT. You make vision possible. You were born into this world to bring LIGHT and truth into the world. Jesus, You shine in the darkness—and the darkness cannot overcome You! You are more powerful than darkness!! Just like walking into a dark room and turning on a light—the LIGHT overcomes the darkness. Jesus, even though I see darkness all around me—the brokenness of the world—You have come into the world to bring salvation. You have come to be the sacrifice and solution to our darkness. You are LIGHT—You allow me to see truth and You reveal truth. You say that when I follow You, I will not walk in darkness—but will have the LIGHT of life. Thank You Jesus for leading my way, revealing truth and breaking into the darkness!! I worship You Jesus for being LIGHT!!!

How has Jesus been LIGHT to you? Thank Him, praise Him, and worship Him as the LIGHT today!!



DAY FIFTY
LION

And I saw a strong angel proclaiming with a loud voice, “Who is worthy to open the book and to break its seals?” And no one in heaven, or on the earth, or under the earth, was able to open the book, or to look into it. And I began to weep greatly, because no one was found worthy to open the book, or to look into it; and one of the elders said to me, “Stop weeping; behold, the LION that is from the tribe of Judah, the Root of David, has overcome so as to open the book and its seven seals.” Revelation 5:2–5 (NASB)

DEFINITION OF **LION**: A person of outstanding interest or importance: a very important, powerful, or successful person: a large wild cat that has golden brown fur and that lives mainly in Africa

Jesus, You are the LION! You are the One who has OVERCOME and who is WORTHY to open the book! You are worthy because You gave Your life for our sins! Jesus, as a LION, You have great strength, You are mighty and strong! You are all-powerful and all-knowing! I think of the way C. S. Lewis portrays Jesus as the Lion, Aslan. “Safe?” said Mr. Beaver; “don’t you hear what Mrs. Beaver tells you? Who said anything about safe? ‘Course he isn’t safe. But he’s good. He’s the King, I tell you.”¹ You are not a “tame lion” that I can manipulate or convince to do what I think is best. But because You are good and love me—I can trust that you will always do what is right! You are more powerful than I can ever imagine—and You reign forever as the sovereign King—the LION!! Jesus, when I think of you as a LION, I bow in awe and wonder at who You are—the mighty, powerful King—the LION!!

How do you see Jesus as the LION? Thank Him, praise Him, and worship Him as the LION today!!



DAY FIFTY-ONE
LIVING STONE

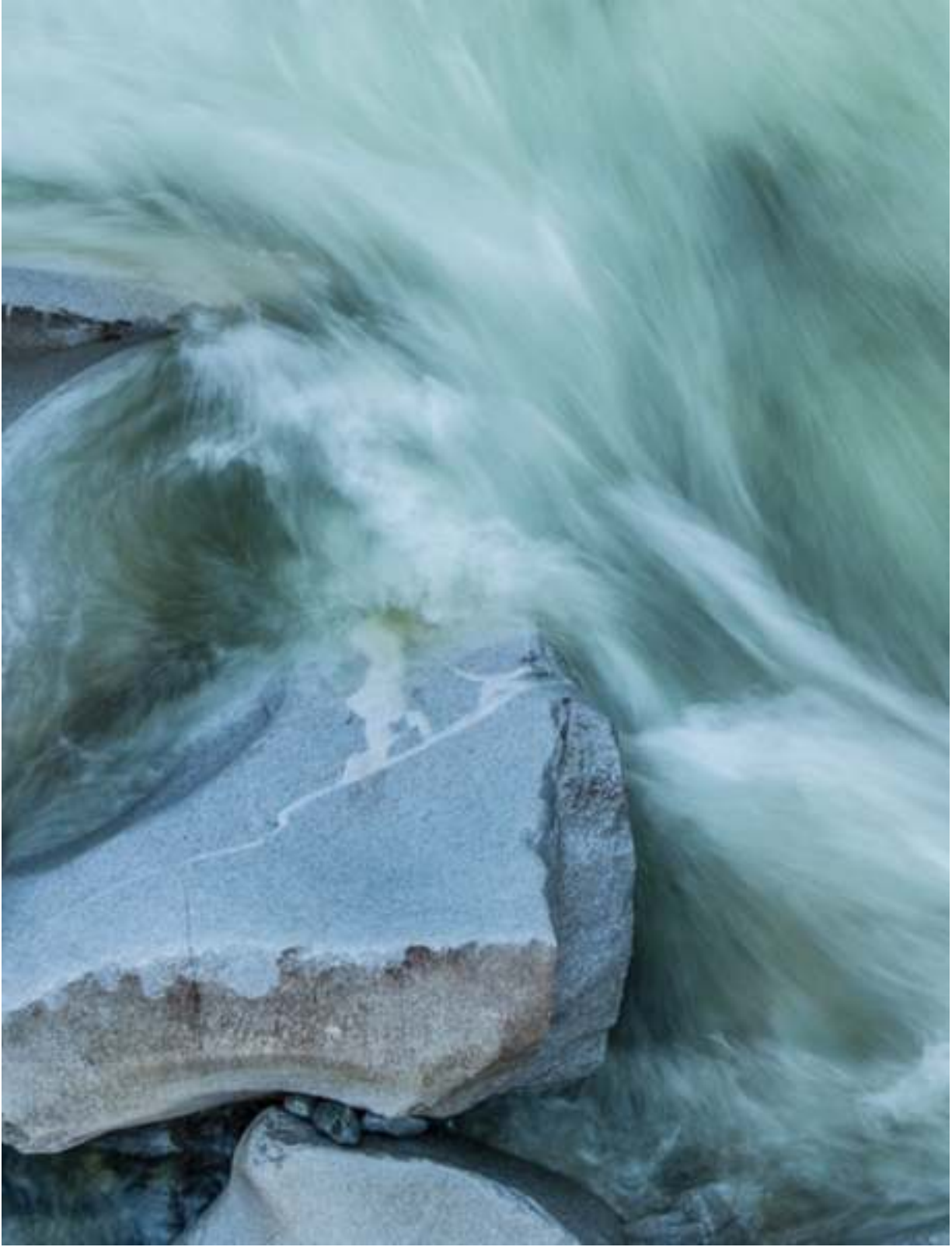

DEFINITION OF **LIVING**: Having life: active, functioning: full of life or vigor: not dead

DEFINITION OF **STONE**: A piece of rock for a specified function: a building block: a paving block: a precious stone

Jesus, You are a LIVING STONE. You are alive, active, functioning, and full of life and vigor! You are not dead and lifeless. You are leading and guiding and moving in my life. You were raised from the dead and are alive! You were rejected by men, but You are choice and precious in the sight of God. You are the foundation; the building block, the precious cornerstone. I will not be disappointed when I place my belief in You because You are the LIVING STONE—the Chosen One who is a solid, unchanging rock!!

How do you see Jesus as your unchanging LIVING STONE? Thank Him, praise Him, and worship Him as your LIVING STONE today!!



DAY FIFTY-TWO
LIVING WATER

The woman said to him, “Sir, you have nothing to draw water with, and the well is deep. Where do you get that LIVING WATER?” . . . Jesus said to her, “Everyone who drinks of this water will be thirsty again, but whoever drinks of the water that I will give him will never be thirsty again. The water that I will give him will become in him a spring of water welling up to eternal life.” The woman said to Him “Sir, give me this WATER, so that I will not be thirsty or have to come here to draw water.” John 4:11, 13–

15

DEFINITION OF **LIVING**: Having life: alive: active, functioning: full of life or vigor: not dead

DEFINITION OF **WATER**: The clear liquid that has no color, taste, or smell, that falls from clouds as rain, that forms streams, lakes, and seas, and that is used for drinking

Jesus, You are LIVING WATER! You are the WATER that is active, and alive in my life! Jesus, You came to this earth, died on the cross and rose again to provide a salvation that would satisfy forever! Jesus, You knew that the woman at the well had needs that were not being satisfied. She had needs that only You could fill. Jesus, You also know my needs. Thank You for being the LIVING WATER that causes me to never thirst again! Thank You, Jesus, for coming to this earth to provide LIVING WATER to satisfy my true need! I worship You—my LIVING WATER!!

Are you being satisfied by Jesus, the LIVING WATER? Thank Him, praise Him, and worship Him as your LIVING WATER today!



DAY FIFTY-THREE

LORD

That disciple whom Jesus loved therefore said to Peter, “It is the Lord!” When Simon Peter heard that it was the Lord, he put on his outer garment, for he was stripped for work, and threw himself into the sea. The other disciples came in the boat, dragging the net full of fish, for they were not far from the land, but about a hundred yards off. DEFINITION OF LORD: One having power and authority and leadership over others: a ruler to whom service and obedience are due

Jesus, this story is so personal—it reveals the love You and your disciples have for each other. You call them “children” even though they are huge, rough fisherman. You told them to try again and then YOU provided everything they were trying to do on their own. 153 fish! Jesus, You are my beloved LORD. You have gentle authority over me. You provide for me and You can be trusted! I owe You my service, obedience, and worship!

DAY FIFTY-FOUR
LORD GOD ALMIGHTY

... and day and night they never cease to say, "Holy, holy, holy is the LORD GOD ALMIGHTY, who was and is and is to come!" They cast their crowns before the throne, saying, "Worthy are you, our LORD and GOD, to receive glory and honor and power, for You created all things, and by Your will they existed and were created." Revelation 4:8b, 10b-11

DEFINITION OF **LORD**: One having power and authority over others :a ruler by hereditary right or preeminence to whom service and obedience are due

DEFINITION OF **GOD**: A Being that has great power, strength, knowledge: the Being perfect in power, wisdom, and goodness who is worshipped as creator and ruler of the universe: a person or thing of supreme value

DEFINITION OF **ALMIGHTY**: Having absolute power over all: relatively unlimited in power or importance

Jesus, You are the LORD GOD ALMIGHTY—worthy of my worship! The Ruler who has authority and power! You are perfect in strength, wisdom, and goodness. You have supreme value and absolute power over all!! It is all about You, JESUS, and no one else. You created all things and by Your will they exist. Period. LORD OF GLORY

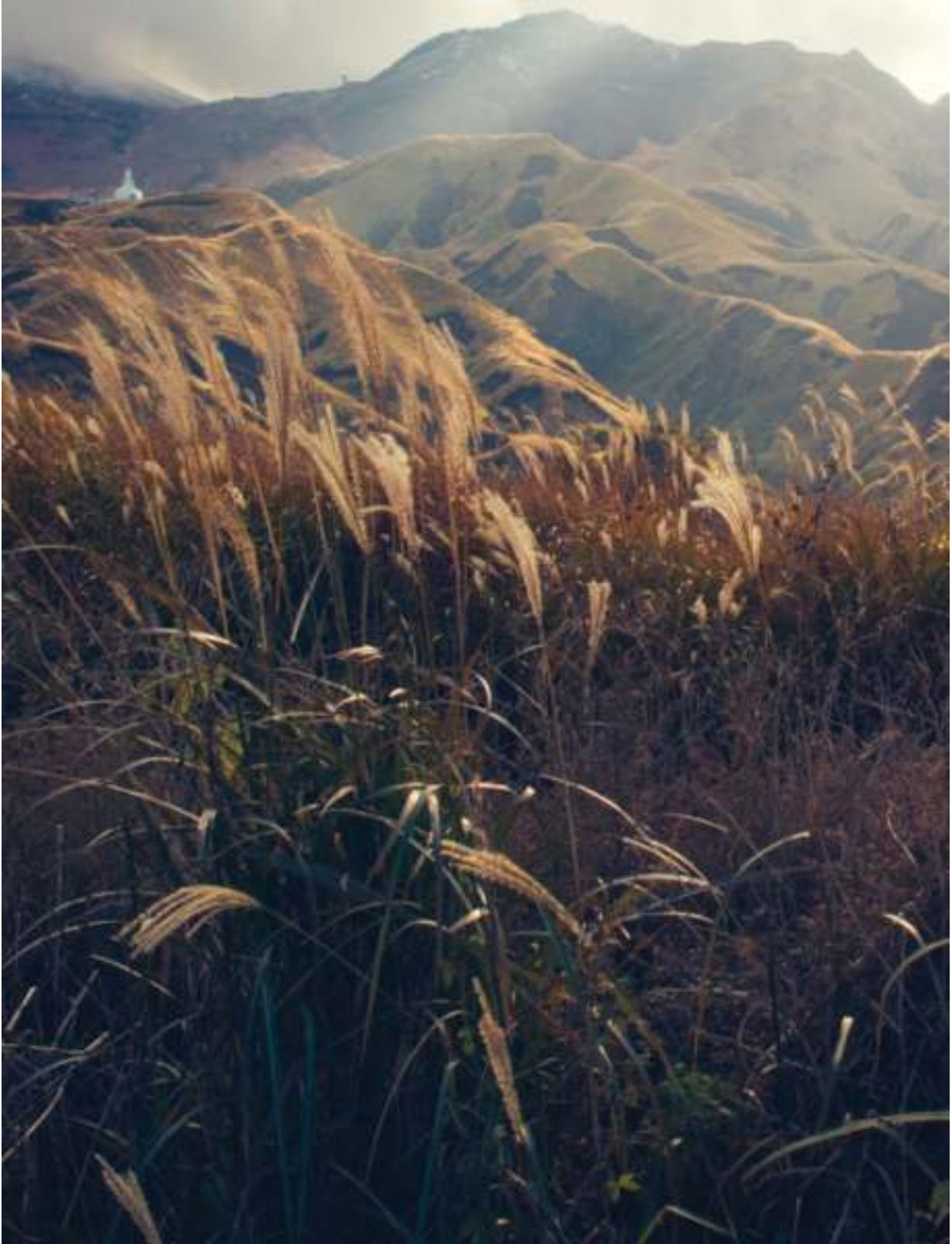

DEFINITION OF **GLORY**: Something that secures praise or renown: great beauty and splendor: magnificence; brilliance: something that brings honor, praise, or fame

You are the LORD OF GLORY!! You are the One with power and authority who is of great beauty, magnificence, brilliance, and splendor! Paul is preaching about the secret and hidden wisdom of You, God. The rulers, at the time You lived, didn't understand or they would not have crucified You—the LORD OF GLORY. The secret and hidden wisdom of God is more than our eyes have seen, or our ears have heard, or our heart has imagined. You were misunderstood and crucified by the ones You came to save. DEFINITION OF **LORD**: A person who has authority, control, or power over others: a master or ruler: a title given to God or Jesus Christ

You have eternal dominion—absolute ownership—of eternity. You were born once in a manger, but You are coming again at the proper time! DEFINITION OF **SORROW**: Deep distress, sadness

After studying all of Your beautiful names, Jesus, and seeing Your glory so much clearer—this name absolutely wrecks me. You were not a celebrity. You were despised and hated. You were pierced and crushed. Chastened and scourged. Oppressed and afflicted. Slaughtered. Yet You came and allowed the sin of us all to fall on You. You were like a silent lamb led to slaughter. Oh Jesus, thank You for taking my sin upon You and dying in my place. You are my Savior, the MAN OF SORROWS. I bow in worship to You, my Jesus.

Can you comprehend His love for you? Thank Him, praise Him, and worship Him, the MAN OF SORROWS, today!!



DAY SIXTY
MEDIATOR

For there is one God, and one MEDIATOR also between God and men, the man Christ Jesus, who gave Himself as a ransom for all, the testimony given at the proper time. 1 Timothy 2:5–6 (NASB)

DEFINITION OF **MEDIATOR**: One that mediates between parties at variance to reconcile differences

Jesus, You are my MEDIATOR. You gave Yourself to pay the debt that I could not pay. You intervened to reconcile me to God. You gave Your life as a ransom to pay what I owe. As if I were standing guilty before a Judge in a court, and You came and paid the fine for me. It is finished. It is done. I am free. I am not guilty anymore. You are the MEDIATOR. You have reconciled me to God. You have paid the debt. I can live in that truth, and stand holy and blameless before You because of what You did, Jesus (Eph. 1:4). DAY SIXTY-ONE

For because He Himself has suffered when tempted, He is able to help those who are being tempted. Hebrews 2:17–18

“Have MERCY on us, Son of David!” Then He touched their eyes, saying, “Be it done to you according to your faith.” And their eyes were opened. Matthew 9:27b, 29

DEFINITION OF MERCIFUL: Treating people with kindness and forgiveness: not cruel or harsh: compassionate: providing relief

Jesus, You are MERCIFUL! You treated people with kindness and forgiveness. You were never cruel or harsh, but compassionate and MERCIFUL! Jesus, You always welcomed the children, the sick, the blind, and the diseased. Thousands followed You to be healed, even when You were weary and worn out. DAY SIXTY-TWO
MESSIAH

The woman said to Him, “I know that MESSIAH is coming (He who is called Christ); when that One comes, He will declare all things to us.” Jesus said to her, “I who speak to you am He.” John 4:25–26 (NASB)

DEFINITION OF MESSIAH: Anointed: the expected king and deliverer of the Jews: a person who is expected to save people from a very bad situation: Jesus

Jesus, You are the MESSIAH! You are the One they were looking for to rescue them and set up an earthly kingdom. Jesus, You told the woman at the well that You were the Messiah she was looking for, and she went back and told everyone in her city that You were the Christ, the MESSIAH. But You did not set up an earthly kingdom like they were expecting. Your plans are so much greater than we could have ever imagined! Jesus, there are times when You don't do what I am expecting, and I feel disappointed and discouraged. But You have a much bigger plan—one that I cannot yet see. DEFINITION OF **MIGHTY**: Possessing might: powerful: accomplished or characterized by might: great or imposing in size or extent: extraordinary: having or showing great strength or power: very great

DEFINITION OF **GOD**: The supreme or ultimate reality: the Being perfect in power, wisdom, and goodness who is worshipped as creator and ruler of the universe: a being or object believed to have more than natural attributes and powers and to require human worship: a person or thing of supreme value: a powerful ruler

Jesus, You are the MIGHTY GOD! You are powerful, great, extraordinary, influential, significant, and strong! You are perfect in power, wisdom, and goodness, and You have supreme value! You are our MIGHTY GOD!! Jesus, my view of You is too small! It is as if You are saying, “Look up! See who I really am!!!” I am looking down at this earth and all of the brokenness that surrounds me, and You are calling me to lift my eyes and see who You are! You are MIGHTIER than I can ever imagine! Enlarge my view of You, Jesus! I worship You today Jesus—thank You for coming to earth as a Child to show Yourself to me as a MIGHTY GOD!

MINISTER IN THE SANCTUARY

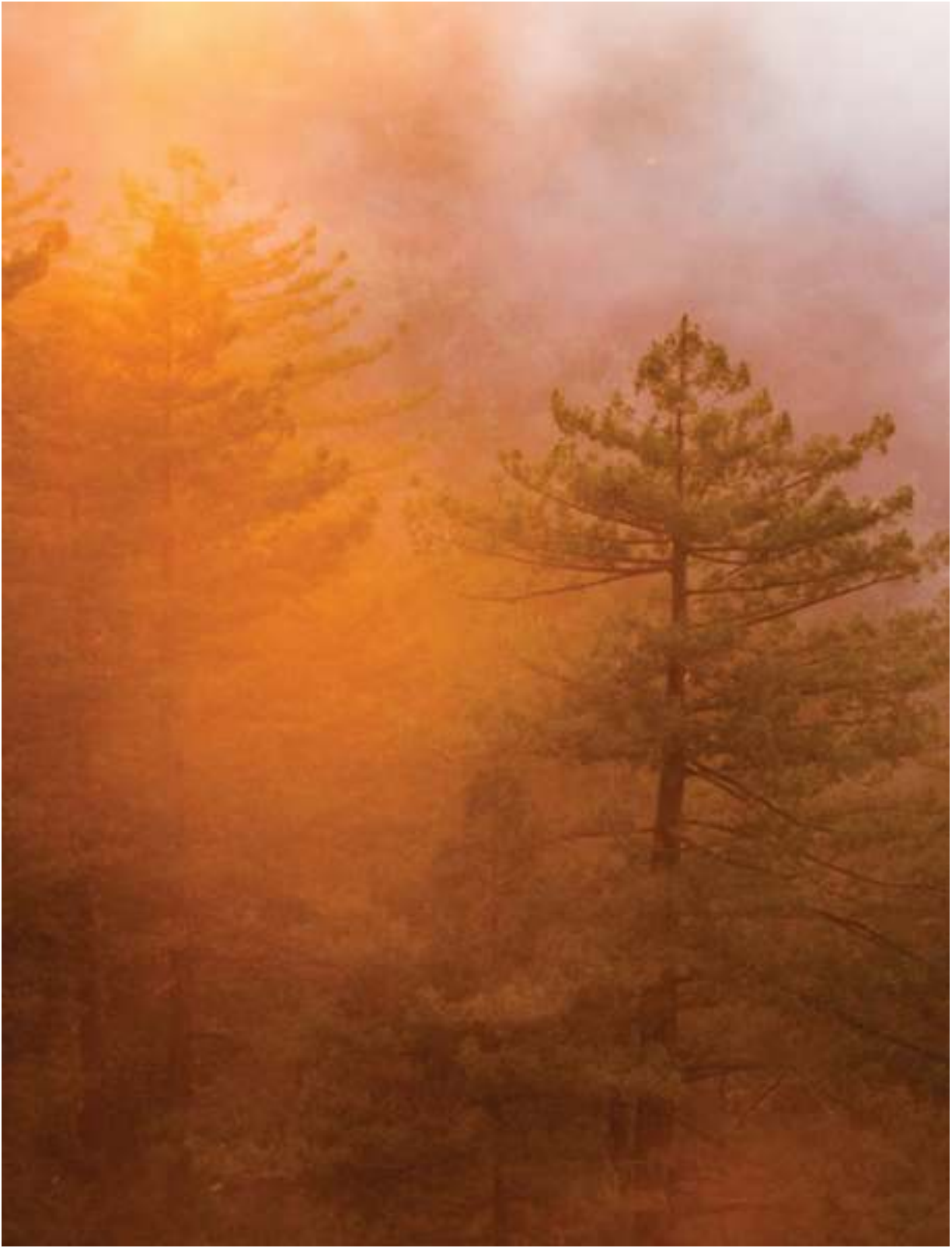

DEFINITION OF MINISTER: A person whose job involves performing religious ceremonies, and providing spiritual or religious guidance to other people

DEFINITION OF SANCTUARY: a place where someone or something is protected or given shelter

Jesus, You are a MINISTER IN THE SANCTUARY! You are a high priest forever (Heb. 7:24–28) because of what You did on the cross. You have taken Your seat at the right hand of the throne of the Majesty, and You are in the true tabernacle in heaven with God! We made the earthly tabernacle, but God set up the heavenly tabernacle. Again, this name points to the gospel. You are a MINISTER IN THE SANCTUARY of heaven because of what You did on the cross. Thank You Jesus for offering up Yourself that I might live forever with You in eternity in the tabernacle in heaven with God! Jesus, You sit at the right hand of the Majesty in the heaven as a MINISTER IN THE SANCTUARY!

How can you worship Him today—the One who sits at the right hand of the throne of the Majesty? Thank Him, praise Him, and worship Him as your MINISTER IN THE SANCTUARY today!!



DAY SIXTY-FIVE

MY LORD AND MY GOD

Then He said to Thomas, “Reach here your finger, and see My hands; and reach here your hand and put it into My side; and do not be unbelieving, but believing.” Thomas answered and said to Him, “MY LORD AND MY GOD!” John 20:27–28

DEFINITION OF **LORD**: One having power and authority over others: a ruler by hereditary right or preeminence to whom service and obedience are due

DEFINITION OF **GOD**: The supreme or ultimate reality: the Being perfect in power, wisdom, and goodness who is worshipped as creator and ruler of the universe

Jesus, You are MY LORD AND MY GOD! Oh Jesus, this story shows how much You care personally and intimately for each one of us. As Thomas had doubts and questions and refused to believe, You went to Him personally and answered his very specific questions. You are the same way with me; so specific in the way You show Yourself. You are very personal in Your care for me. Because I wander, I have doubts and I lose my affection for You so easily. When I have doubts, You patiently remind me that You are with me. Your relationship with me is so personal and individual. When You showed Yourself to Thomas, he said “MY LORD and MY GOD!” You belonged to him. You were his personal LORD and his personal GOD! Oh Jesus, thank You for being so personal, caring, and for being so patient to answer my questions. You are MY LORD AND MY GOD!

DAY SIXTY-SIX
MY SERVANT

But the Lord was pleased to crush Him, putting Him to grief; if He would render Himself as a guilt offering, He will see His offering, He will prolong His days, and the good pleasure of the Lord will prosper in His hand. As a result of the anguish of His soul, He will see it and be satisfied; by His knowledge the Righteous One, My Servant, will justify the many, as He will bear their inequities.
Isaiah 53:10–11 (NASB)

DEFINITION OF **MY**: Used to express affection for someone you are talking to

DEFINITION OF **SERVANT**: One that serves others

Jesus, You were God's SERVANT. He called you MY to show His affection for You, His Son. You were called to serve by giving Your life as an “offering for guilt.” God transferred the guilt of sin from me to You, Jesus. And then You were crushed to satisfy the payment for my sin. Because of Your payment for my sin, I will be “accounted as righteous.” This Scripture is the perfect definition of what You did for me, Jesus. You had one purpose—to be the offering for my guilt. What kind of man would allow the sin of mankind to be placed on Him? Only You. Only someone who loves me with an unbelievable love. You are the only One who will satisfy my deepest longing to be loved. Only You love me with this kind of love. I worship and praise You today, Jesus, the One who is God’s SERVANT to provide a way for all mankind to live with You forever!

DAY SIXTY-SEVEN
NAZARENE

So Joseph got up, took the Child and His mother, and came into the land of Israel. But when he heard that Archelaus was reigning over Judea in place of his father Herod, he was afraid to go there. Then after being warned by God in a dream he left for the regions of Galilee, and came and lived in a city called NAZARETH. This was to fulfill what was spoken through the prophets: “He shall be called a NAZARENE.” Matthew 2:20–23 (NASB)

DEFINITION OF NAZARENE: a native or resident of Nazareth

Jesus, You were a NAZARENE. You were fully man and fully God, born in Bethlehem and raised in NAZARETH. NAZARETH was a small village that was apparently despised by the Jews because it housed a Roman fort. Anyone from NAZARETH was despised; this is why Nathanael said in John 1:46 “Can any good thing come out of NAZARETH?” (NASB). God, You planned for Jesus to be born to poor parents, in a feeding trough, and to be raised in a town that was despised. Jesus Himself was despised (Isa. 53:3). You choose the weak things of the world to confound the wise (1 Cor. 1:26–31). We think that riches and wealth, wisdom, and status are important, but You take the poor, the weak, and the despised and You use them for Your purposes and Your glory. Oh Jesus, help me to see things from Your perspective. You have a plan that is different from what I expect. Your ways are higher and greater, and You deserve all the glory! I worship You, Jesus, the NAZARENE!!

Do you believe God can use you for His glory? Thank Him, praise Him, and worship Him as a NAZARENE today!!



DAY SIXTY-EIGHT
PASSOVER LAMB

*For Christ, our PASSOVER LAMB, has been sacrificed. 1
Corinthians 5:7*

*For the Lord will pass through to smite the Egyptians; and when
He sees the blood on the lintel and on the two doorposts, the Lord
will PASS OVER the door and will not allow the destroyer to come
in to your houses to smite you. Exodus 12:23 (NASB)*

DEFINITION OF **PASSOVER**: A Jewish holiday beginning on the 14th of Nisan and commemorating the Hebrews' liberation from slavery in Egypt; the exemption of the Israelites from the slaughter of the firstborn in Egypt (Exod. 12)

Jesus, You are our **PASSOVER LAMB**! While slaves in Egypt, the Jews were instructed to put the blood of an **UNBLEMISHED LAMB** on the lintel and doorpost of their household. When God **PASSED OVER**, He would see the blood and spare every household that had blood on the lintel and doorpost. However, every Egyptian's home that did not have the blood of the **PASSOVER LAMB** on their doorpost would lose their first-born (Exod. 11–13). Jesus, You were the **PASSOVER LAMB** that died for me. If I believe in what You did for me, I am covered, will be set free, and will live forever with You. I've done nothing to deserve or earn it, and neither did the Jews. The truth that You would come to earth to be the sacrificial **PASSOVER LAMB** for me is more than I can bear. Jesus, I bow before You and worship You with my life. You are my **PASSOVER LAMB**!!

DAY SIXTY-NINE
PHYSICIAN

When the scribes of the Pharisees saw that He was eating with the sinners and tax collectors, they said to His disciples, “Why is He eating and drinking with tax collectors and sinners?” And hearing this, Jesus said to them, “It is not those who are healthy who need a PHYSICIAN, but those who are sick; I did not come to call the righteous, but sinners.” Mark 2:16–17 (NASB)

DEFINITION OF PHYSICIAN: One educated, clinically experienced, and licensed to practice medicine

Jesus, You are my PHYSICIAN! I have come to the place that I know I cannot heal myself. It is humbling to admit that I need help and that I may have to wait or be inconvenienced in some way. I would much rather figure out a way to heal myself! People who are “righteous” believe they can “heal themselves.” They think they have it together on their own, and they don’t need a PHYSICIAN. But sinners, those in pain and those who know they cannot make it on their own, run to Jesus as their PHYSICIAN. C. S. Lewis says “God whispers to us in our pleasures, . . . but shouts in our pain: it is His megaphone to rouse a deaf world.”² Lord, You know I had to get to the “end of myself” before I ran to You, Jesus. You were waiting for me. You are the only PHYSICIAN who can heal me for all eternity! You know I can’t be “righteous” on my own. Jesus, You are my PHYSICIAN—You are the One I run to. I worship You, and thank You for being the One I need—my PHYSICIAN!

Are you trying to be “righteous” on your own? Run to Jesus! Thank Him, praise Him, and worship Him as your PHYSICIAN today!!



DAY SEVENTY
PRINCE OF PEACE

For a Child will be born to us, a Son will be given to us; and the government will rest on His shoulders; and His name will be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Eternal Father, PRINCE OF PEACE. There will be no end to the increase of His government or of PEACE. Isaiah 9:6–7a (NASB)

These things I have spoken to you, so that in Me you may have PEACE. John 16:33a (NASB)

DEFINITION OF PRINCE: A male member of a royal family: a son of the king

DEFINITION OF PEACE: Freedom from disquieting or oppressive thoughts or emotions: the absence or end of strife: a pact or agreement to end hostilities between those who have been at war or in a state of enmity

Jesus, You are the PRINCE OF PEACE. Oh, how we are desperate for PEACE in our world and our hearts. We long for the “absence or end of strife” that is within us, and the strife that we see all around. You are the PRINCE—the Son of the King—the male member of the royal family—who has brought us PEACE. When You were born, you brought a PEACE to which there will be no end. You are the One who made PEACE between God and man, PEACE in our own hearts, and PEACE for all eternity. Jesus, I fall down at Your feet to worship You, Jesus—the PRINCE OF PEACE!!!

Are you experiencing His PEACE—knowing that He has overcome the world? Thank Him, praise Him, and worship Him as your PRINCE OF PEACE today!!

PROPITIATION

My little children, I am writing these things to you so that you may not sin. But if anyone does sin, we have an Advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous. He is the PROPITIATION for our sins, and not for ours only but also for the sins of the whole world. 1 John 2:1–2

For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, and are justified by His grace as a gift, through the redemption that is in Jesus Christ, whom God put forward as a PROPITIATION by His blood, to be received by faith. Romans 3:23–25a

DEFINITION OF PROPITIATE: To gain or regain the favor or goodwill of: appease: an atoning sacrifice

Jesus, You are my PROPITIATION! You are the One who paid the debt that I owed to “regain or gain the favor or goodwill of” God. In *The Lion, the Witch and the Wardrobe*, C. S. RADIANCE OF HIS GLORY

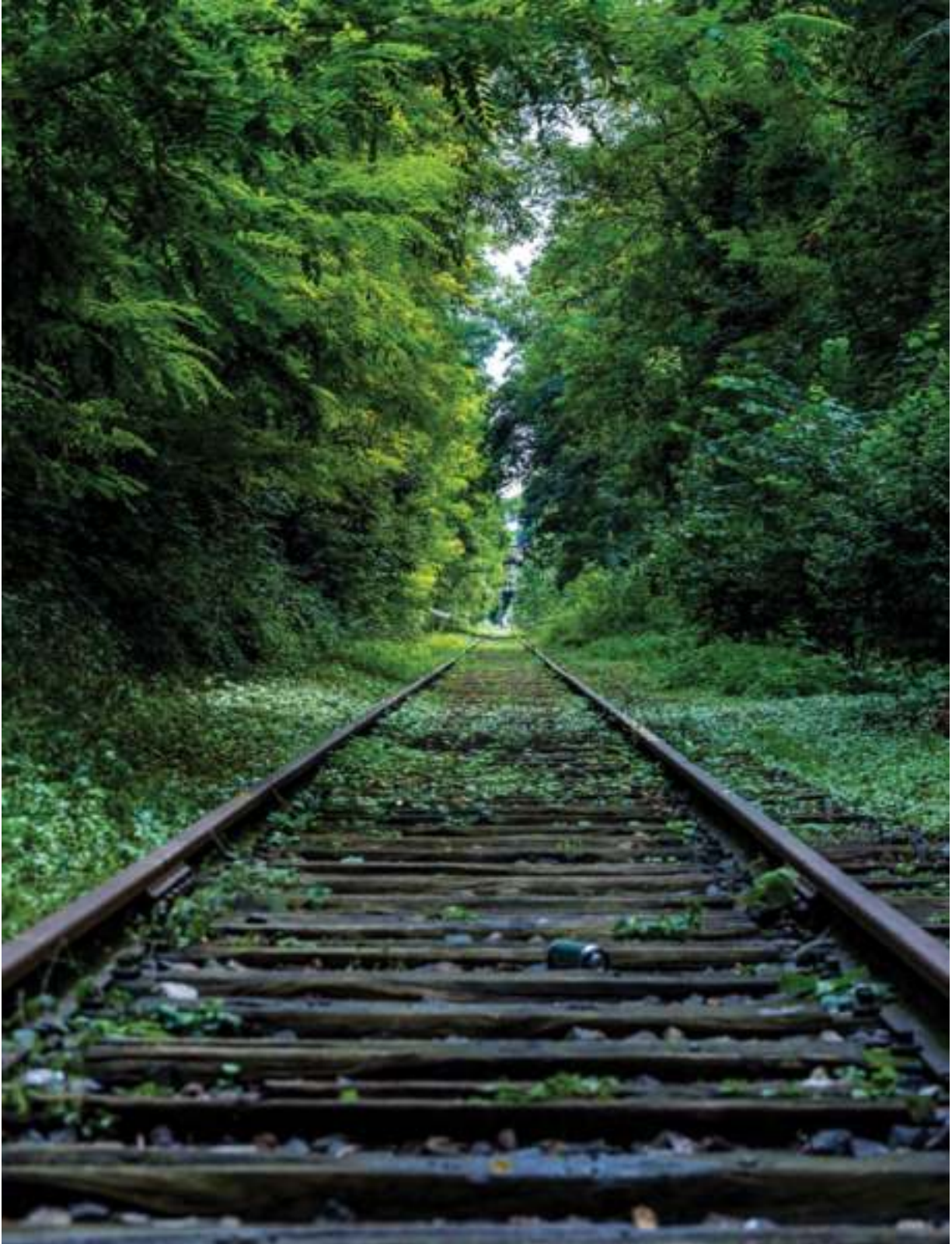

DEFINITION OF **RADIANCE**: To emit light or splendor

DEFINITION OF **GLORY**: Renown: great beauty and splendor: magnificence

Jesus is the **RADIANCE**—brightness, brilliancy, dazzle, illumination, lambency, lightness, luminance, luminosity, luster, lustrousness, brilliance, splendor—**OF HIS GLORY**—acclaim, accolade, applause, credit, distinction, homage, honor, laurels, éclame. Jesus, You are the brilliancy of His acclaim and honor. You shine with brightness that reflects the applause that His **GLORY** deserves. DAY SEVENTY-THREE

RANSOM

For there is one God, and one mediator also between God and men, the man Christ Jesus, who gave Himself as a RANSOM for all. 1 Timothy 2:5–6a (NASB)

For even the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give His life a RANSOM for many. Mark 10:45 (NASB)

DEFINITION OF **RANSOM**: To free from captivity or punishment by paying a price: to deliver especially from sin or its penalty

Jesus, You were the One to rescue, deliver, redeem, reclaim, and save me—by being the RANSOM for my sin. This was the reason You came to earth. Everything You did pointed to it. This is not what I expected when I started studying Your names, Jesus. I thought they would be beautiful names that would be somehow applicable to my everyday life. DAY SEVENTY-FOUR
REDEEMER

“And a REDEEMER will come to Zion, and to those who turn from transgression in Jacob,” declares the Lord. Isaiah 59:20 (NASB)

For He delivered us from the domain of darkness, and transferred us to the kingdom of His beloved Son, in whom we have REDEMPTION, the forgiveness of sins. Colossians 1:13

DEFINITION OF **REDEEMER**: A person who redeems; Jesus

DEFINITION OF **REDEEM**: To buy back: to free from captivity by payment of ransom: to release from blame or debt: clear: to free from the consequences of sin

Jesus, You are my REDEEMER! You have delivered me from the power of Satan and have given me forgiveness of my sins. You paid the penalty for me. I can live in the knowledge that You have REDEEMED me. If I trust in what You have done for me, there is no condemnation for the sins I have committed. You have REDEEMED me. You have PAID for my sin. It is finished. DAY SEVENTY-FIVE
RECONCILER

Now all these things are from God, who RECONCILED us to Himself through Christ and gave us the ministry of RECONCILIATION, namely, that God was in Christ RECONCILING the world to Himself, not counting their trespasses against them, and He has committed to us the word of RECONCILIATION. 2 Corinthians 5:18–19 (NASB)

For if while we were enemies we were RECONCILED to God through the death of His Son, much more, having been RECONCILED, we shall be saved by His life. Romans 5:11

DEFINITION OF RECONCILE: To restore to friendship or harmony: Used of the divine work of redemption insofar as God Himself, by taking upon Himself our sin and becoming an atonement, establishes the relationship of peace with mankind⁴

Jesus, You are my RECONCILER! You are the One who restored my relationship of peace with You and made a way for me to know You! Even though I was not seeking You, You took on my sin, and made a way for me to be holy and blameless before You. You did not ask me to be perfect or to earn my relationship with You. I now have no guilt or shame as I stand before You because You RECONCILED me to You! Thank You God for making a way for me. You didn't wait for me to ask You for forgiveness—You forgave me while I was in my sin. Jesus, THANK YOU for being my RECONCILER!!

DAY SEVENTY-SIX

RESURRECTION AND THE LIFE

Jesus said to her, “I am the RESURRECTION AND THE LIFE; he who believes in Me will live even if he dies, and everyone who lives and believes in Me will never die. Do you believe this?” She said to Him, “Yes, Lord; I have believed that You are the Christ, the Son of God, even He who comes into the world.” John 11:25–27 (NASB)

DEFINITION OF **RESURRECTION**: The rising of Christ from the dead

DEFINITION OF **LIFE**: The experience of being alive

Jesus, You are the RESURRECTION AND THE LIFE! You are rebirth, renewal, and revitalization! This is not just an event that will happen on the last day—You are the RESURRECTION AND THE LIFE. You are the power that gives LIFE and keeps everything alive! As Deity, You claimed to have power over life and death, and then You proceeded to prove that You are the RESURRECTION AND THE LIFE by raising Lazarus from the dead! Only the One who holds life and death in His hands can raise someone from the dead. DAY SEVENTY-SEVEN
RISEN ONE

Remember how He spoke to you while He was still in Galilee, saying that the Son of Man must be delivered into the hands of sinful men, and be crucified, and the third day RISE again?” Luke 24:2–7 (NASB)

DEFINITION OF RISE: To return from death

Jesus, You are RISEN!! You were dead, and now You are alive! I have heard this all my life and it tends to lose its power to amaze me. But Lord, if I saw someone come back to life, I would be terrified and drop down on the ground! Your disciples never got over it! You told them everything that was going to happen—your arrest, crucifixion, burial, and that You would RISE again on the third day! It occurred just as You said! It says in Acts 1:3 that You appeared to them over a period of 40 days after Your resurrection and before Your ascension. The rest of their lives they lived to tell others about You. It is TRUE!!! You alone are worthy of my worship!!!

DAY SEVENTY-EIGHT

ROCK

For I do not want you to be unaware, brethren, that our fathers were all under the cloud, and all passed through the sea; and all were baptized into Moses in the cloud and in the sea; and all ate the same spiritual food; and all drank the same spiritual drink, for they were drinking from a spiritual ROCK which followed them; and the ROCK was Christ. 1 Corinthians 10:1–4 (NASB)

The Lord is my ROCK and my fortress and my deliverer, my God, my ROCK, in whom I take refuge; my shield and the horn of my salvation, my stronghold. Psalm 18:2 (NASB)

DEFINITION OF ROCK: A large mass of stone forming a cliff, promontory, or peak: something like a rock in firmness: foundation, support: refuge

Jesus, You are my ROCK! You are my foundation, support, and refuge! In the Old Testament, You were the ROCK that provided the Living Water (John 4:10–14) for the Israelites in the wilderness (Exod. 17:1–7; Num. 20:1–13). DAY SEVENTY-NINE

When Herod the king heard this, he was troubled, and all Jerusalem with him; and assembling all the chief priests and scribes of the people, he inquired of them where the Christ was to be born. They told him, "In Bethlehem of Judea, for so it has been written by the prophet: And you, O Bethlehem, in the land of Judah, are by no means least among the rulers of Judah; for from you shall come a RULER, who will shepherd My people Israel." Matthew 2:1–6

DEFINITION OF RULER: A person (as a king or queen) having supreme power over a nation: one that rules: sovereign

DAY EIGHTY
SAVIOR

DEFINITION OF **SAVIOR**: One that saves from danger or destruction: one who brings salvation: Jesus

Jesus, You are my SAVIOR! You are the One who has SAVED me from destruction. You are my Deliverer, Redeemer, Rescuer! I realize that I often look to other things to be my Savior. Without even realizing it, I look to a relationship, marriage, children, a career, money, esteem . . . something that I think will be the “answer” to all of my problems. DEFINITION OF **SERVANT**: One that serves others

DEFINITION OF **SERVE**: To be a servant: to be of use: to be worthy of reliance or trust: to help persons to food: to wait at table: to set out portions of food or drink: to wait on customers: to comply with the commands or demands of: gratify: to perform the duties of: present, provide: to furnish or supply with something needed or desired: to wait on (a customer) in a store: to furnish professional service to: to answer the needs of: to be enough for: suffice: to contribute to: to provide services that benefit or help

Jesus, You are a **SERVANT**—The Ultimate **SERVANT**. As I look at these definitions—they are all acts of serving. You did not come to **BE** served—but to **SERVE**. You were the greatest example of **SERVANTHOOD** this world has ever known. You laid down Your life for me. DAY EIGHTY-TWO



SHEPHERD

DEFINITION OF **SHEPHERD**: A person who tends sheep: to guide or guard in the manner of a shepherd: pastor

Jesus, You are my SHEPHERD! You counsel, lead, and show me the way! You are the One who guides and guards as a SHEPHERD who takes care of His sheep. Someone who does not own the sheep would flee when danger comes, but You are the One who cares, protects and dies for me. You came that I might have abundant life, now and for eternity. DAY EIGHTY-THREE

DEFINITION OF SINLESS: Free from sin: impeccable

Jesus, You are SINLESS! You are impeccable, pure, and completely innocent of any sin! You never had a proud thought. You did not think too highly of Yourself or too low of Yourself. You were never angry for the wrong reason. You were never afraid. You never had a negative thought about someone; or gossiped, or slandered, or spoke a wrong word! You never lied. You were never insecure. You were never selfish. You never once had an impure thought or motive! Not even for a minute. You KNEW NO SIN. It is more than my mind can grasp. I, who am so aware of my own sin, cannot even imagine being without sin. This is the “great exchange.” You exchanged Your SINLESS life for my sinful life, so that I might take on Your righteousness. I am now able to stand before You holy and blameless (Eph. 1:4) because of what You did for me. You died on the cross for my sin—in my place—so that I might have your righteousness. DAY EIGHTY-FOUR
SON OF DAVID

The book of the genealogy of Jesus Christ, the SON OF DAVID, the son of Abraham. “. . . and to Jesse was born DAVID the King. And to DAVID was born Solomon by her who had been the wife of Uriah . . . and to Jacob was born Joseph the husband of Mary, by whom was born Jesus, who is called Christ.” Matthew 1:1, 6, 16

(NASB)

DEFINITION OF **SON**: A human male descendant

DEFINITION OF **DAVID**: A Hebrew shepherd who became the second king of Israel in succession to Saul according to biblical accounts

Jesus, You are the SON OF DAVID! You are the male descendant of DAVID, the King of Israel. You have legally descended from the line of David and fulfilled 2 Samuel 7:8–16. Why does this matter? *Therefore the Lord Himself will give you a sign. Behold, the virgin shall conceive and bear a SON, and shall call His name Immanuel.
Isaiah 7:14*

DEFINITION OF **SON**: A human male descendant: the second person of the Trinity

DEFINITION OF **GOD**: The Being perfect in power, wisdom, and goodness

Jesus, You are the SON OF GOD! You are a human male descendant and the divine, perfect SON OF GOD—the Being who is perfect in power, wisdom, and goodness! You were not conceived by man, You are the “holy offspring” of the Holy Spirit born to Mary! You were the exact fulfillment of the prophesy in Isaiah 7:14. DAY EIGHTY-SIX

DEFINITION OF **SON**: A male child: the second person of the Trinity: Jesus Christ

DEFINITION OF **MAN**: The human race: humankind

Jesus, You are the SON OF MAN! You referred to Yourself, at Your trial, as the SON OF MAN—the One who fulfills the prophesy in Daniel 7:13–14. You are the One seated at the right hand of Power and coming on the clouds of heaven! After you said this, the high priests knew that You were declaring that You were God—the One who would be worshipped by all peoples, nations, and men of every language! The people at Your trial had a choice, they could have believed You and worshipped You, or they could have called You a liar and crucified You for claiming to be God. They chose to call You a liar, to spit on You and mock You, and then crucify You. Do I believe You are who You say You are? Do I bow down and worship You as the One who is seated at the right hand of Power—the One whose dominion is everlasting and whose Kingdom has no end? Yes Jesus! Thank You for coming to earth as a baby—Jesus, the SON OF MAN!

Do you believe that Jesus is GOD? Thank Him, praise Him, and worship Him as the SON OF MAN today!!



DAY EIGHTY-SEVEN
SON OF MARY

He went away from there and came to His hometown, and His disciples followed him. And on the Sabbath He began to teach in the synagogue, and many who heard Him were astonished, saying “Where did this man get these things? What is the wisdom given to Him? How are such mighty works done by His hands? Is not this the carpenter, the SON OF MARY, and brother of James, and Joses, and Judas, and Simon? And are not His sisters here with us? And they took offense at Him.” Mark 6:1–3

DEFINITION OF **SON**: A human male descendant

DEFINITION OF **MARY**: The mother of Jesus

Jesus, You were the SON OF MARY! You are completely MAN and completely GOD! You grew up in a family with brothers and sisters. Your job was a simple carpenter. When You began Your ministry, the people in Your hometown were astonished and skeptical at the contrast between Your wisdom and miracles and Your simple upbringing. However, later your two brothers, James (author of the book of James) and Judas (author of the book of Jude), worshipped You as the Lord Jesus Christ and both identified themselves as Your bond-servants! Jesus, You humbled Yourself to be born in this world, to be part of a family, to work a simple job. You understand everything I face because You humbled Yourself to be born into a family on this earth! Thank You Jesus for being completely GOD and completely MAN. I worship You as the SON OF MARY!

Do you believe Jesus understands everything you face? Thank Him, praise Him, and worship Him as the SON OF MARY today!!



DAY EIGHTY-EIGHT
SON OF THE BLESSED ONE

Again the high priest was questioning Him, and saying to Him, “Are You the Christ, the SON OF THE BLESSED ONE?” And Jesus said, “I AM . . . And they all condemned Him to be deserving of death. Some began to spit at Him, and to blindfold Him, and to beat Him with their fists, and to say to Him, ‘Prophesy!’ And the officers received Him with slaps in the face.” Mark 14:61–62a, 64b–65 (NASB)

DEFINITION OF **SON**: The Son: the second person of the Trinity: Jesus Christ

DEFINITION OF **BLESSED**: Having a sacred nature: connected with God: held in reverence: honored in worship: hallowed

Jesus, You are the SON OF THE BLESSED ONE! Oh Jesus, this scripture wrecks me. You are on trial and the high priest asks if You are the SON OF THE BLESSED ONE?—You answer “I AM.” From this, they determine You to be worthy of the death penalty. The Council and Roman officers began to spit at You, blindfold You, beat You, and mock You. The truth is that You died for these soldiers and the Council. You knew exactly what was going to happen. But this was why you came. At Your crucifixion, You said, “Father, forgive them, for they do not know what they do” (Luke 23:34). This is beyond my comprehension. DAY EIGHTY-NINE
SON OF THE MOST HIGH

And the angel said to her, “Do not be afraid, Mary, for you have found favor with God. And behold, you will conceive in your womb and bear a son, and you shall call His name Jesus. He will be great and will be called the SON OF THE MOST HIGH: and the Lord God will give Him the throne of His father David, and He will reign over the house of Jacob forever; and of His kingdom there will be no end.” Luke 1:30–33

DEFINITION OF **SON**: A male child: the second person of the Trinity: Jesus Christ

DEFINITION OF **MOST**: Greatest in quantity, extent, or degree

DEFINITION OF **HIGH**: Exalted in character: noble

Jesus, You are the SON OF THE MOST HIGH! Mary knew exactly what Gabriel meant when he said “SON OF THE MOST HIGH.” She knew that Gabriel meant her child would be EQUAL to GOD! Such astonishing words! God, You sent an angel to tell Mary that she would be the mother of a child who would be the Messiah! DAY NINETY

SOURCE OF ETERNAL SALVATION

DEFINITION OF **SOURCE**: Someone or something that provides what is wanted or needed: the cause of something: a point of origin or procurement: beginning: one that initiates: author

DEFINITION OF **ETERNAL**: Having no beginning and no end in time: lasting forever: existing at all times: always true or valid

DEFINITION OF **SALVATION**: the act of saving someone from sin or evil: the state of being saved from sin or evil: something that saves someone or something from danger or a difficult situation

Jesus, You are the SOURCE OF ETERNAL SALVATION! So often I look to other things in this life as the SOURCE OF MY ETERNAL SALVATION. Jesus, You know that all of these things in the world can never be the SOURCE OF ETERNAL SALVATION for me. You are rooting out that in which I place my dependence. You want me to depend only on You. Because You will never fail. You will never change. You will never leave me. You have given me ETERNAL SALVATION through Your death on the cross! Jesus, YOU are enough because YOU are my center—YOU are my everything. No matter what happens in this world YOU are there for me! Thank You Jesus—You are the true SAVIOR—the SOURCE OF ETERNAL SALVATION!!

What are YOU depending on as your SOURCE? Thank Him, praise Him, and worship Him as your SOURCE OF ETERNAL SALVATION today!!



DAY NINETY-ONE

SOWER

All these things Jesus said to the crowds in parables; indeed, He said nothing to them without a parable. This was to fulfill what was spoken by the prophet: “I will open my mouth in parables; I will utter what has been hidden since the foundation of the world.” Then He left the crowds and went into the house. And His disciples came to Him, saying, “Explain to us the parable of the weeds of the field.” He answered “The ONE WHO SOWS the good seed is the Son of Man.” Matthew 13:34–37

DEFINITION OF **SOW**: To plant seed for growth especially by scattering; to set something in motion

Jesus, You are the SOWER! You are the One who sets things in motion, who causes to exist, who scatters the seed of the truths about the Kingdom of Heaven! You spoke to the crowds in parables; simple stories that taught spiritual truths. You called Yourself the SOWER—the One who sowed the field with the Word and with truth. Your use of parables fulfilled the prophesy in Psalm 78:1–4 and in Isaiah 6:9–10. You used them to reveal mysteries to Your disciples that only they would understand. The people who didn’t believe in You, didn’t understand the stories You told. Jesus, You are the SOWER—the One who reveals truth about the Kingdom of Heaven! Jesus, give me a heart like the disciples, who longed to know the TRUTH You were teaching! I worship You Jesus, the One who reveals TRUTH—the SOWER!!

Do you long to know the truths Jesus taught? Thank Him, praise Him, and worship Him as the SOWER today!!



DAY NINETY-TWO
STAR & SCEPTER

The oracle of him who hears the words of God, and knows the knowledge of the Most High, who sees the vision of the Almighty, falling down with his eyes uncovered: I see Him, but not now; I behold Him, but not near; a STAR shall come out of Jacob, and a SCEPTER shall rise out of Israel . . . Numbers 24:17

DEFINITION OF **STAR**: A natural luminous body visible in the sky especially at night

DEFINITION OF **SCEPTER**: A staff or baton borne by a sovereign as an emblem of authority: a long decorated stick that is carried by a king or queen

Jesus, You are the STAR and the SCEPTER! The One who was prophesied in the book of Numbers to come in royalty from Israel!! Your coming has been prophesied for hundreds of years! The STAR is a symbol of brightness and an object of wonder, the SCEPTER is a symbol of authority and royalty. These are symbols of Kingship. This vision was given years before and has prepared the way for You to come! You are compared to a STAR because You are a source of constant light that never changes and You give guidance to all. As a SCEPTER, You are the sign of truth and power. You are the STAR and the SCEPTER—Brightness and Royalty—coming to earth as a baby to provide a way for us to spend eternity with You! You are Glorious, King Jesus! I worship and adore You!

DAY NINETY-THREE

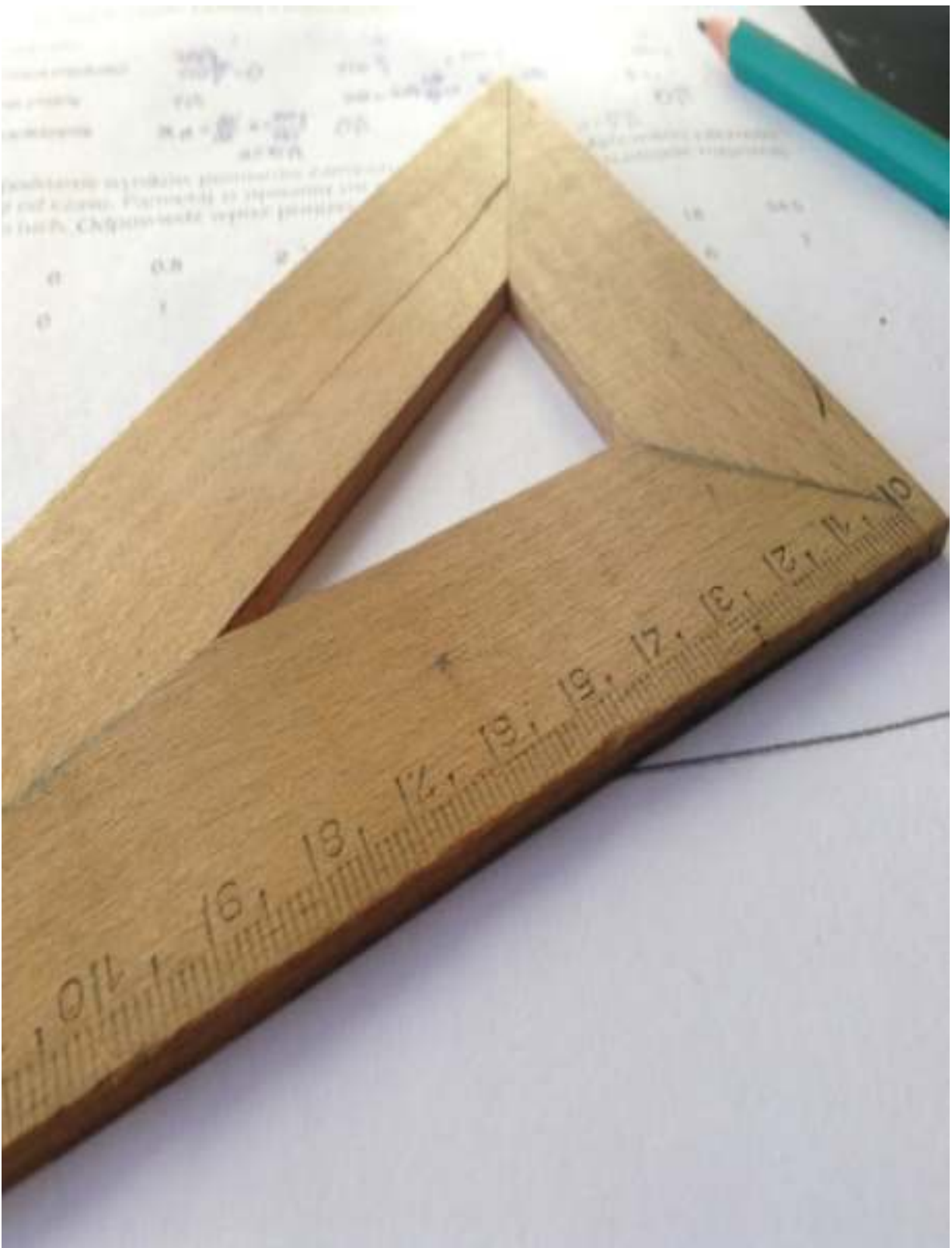
SUNRISE

And his father Zacharias was filled with the Holy Spirit, and prophesied, saying . . . “And you, child, will be called the prophet of the Most High; for you will go before the LORD to prepare His ways; to give to His people the knowledge of salvation by the forgiveness of their sins, because of the tender mercy of our God, with which the SUNRISE from on high will visit us, to shine upon those who sit in darkness and the shadow of death, to guide our feet into the way of peace.” Luke 1:67, 76–78 (NASB)

DEFINITION OF SUNRISE: The time when the sun appears above the horizon in the morning; dawn or daybreak; the colors that are in the sky when the sun slowly appears above the horizon

Jesus, You are the SUNRISE! You are the light that shines with glorious colors in the first break of dawn! This prophesy of Zacharias, the father of John the Baptist, declares that his son would go before You to prepare Your way and to teach people about salvation and the forgiveness of sin. Jesus, You are the One who would shine upon those who sit in darkness and the shadow of death, to guide our feet into the way of peace! You are Jesus—the SUNRISE—the light that has come into the world! John 1:4–5 says, “In Him was life, and the life was the Light of men. The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness did not comprehend it” (NASB). Because of God's TENDER MERCY, He sent You, Jesus, to provide forgiveness of sin through Your death on the cross. Thank you, Jesus, for being the SUNRISE!!

DAY NINETY-FOUR
TEACHER

They came and said to Him, “TEACHER, we know that You are truthful, and defer to no one; for You are not partial to any, but teach the way of God in truth. Is it lawful to pay a poll-tax to Caesar, or not? Shall we pay, or shall we not pay?” But He, knowing their hypocrisy, said to them, “Why are you testing Me? Bring Me a denarius to look at.” And they brought one. And He said to them, “Whose likeness and inscription is this?” And they said to Him, “Caesar’s.” And Jesus said to them, “render to Caesar the things that are Caesar’s, and to God the things that are God’s.” And they were AMAZED at Him. Mark 12:14–17 (NASB)

DEFINITION OF TEACHER: One that teaches: one whose occupation is to instruct

Jesus, You are the great TEACHER! You taught the crowds and instructed people on the way to live! As they said, You were truthful and deferred to no one. But You could see right through their hypocrisy to the motive of their hearts. You are so WISE they could never trap you with their questions! You instructed them to pay to Caesar what was due. But You didn't stop there. You told them to render to God the things that were God's. I have Your image on me—and I belong to You. My life is to be rendered to You. Oh Jesus, You see right through to my heart, to my motives. May I render to You my life as I stand AMAZED at You!! I worship You, the wisest TEACHER who ever lived!!!

Is your life “rendered” to Jesus? Thank Him, praise Him, and worship Him as your TEACHER today!!



DAY NINETY-FIVE
TRUE VINE

“I am the TRUE VINE, and My Father is the vinedresser. Every branch in Me that does not bear fruit He takes away, and every branch that bears fruit He prunes, that it may bear more fruit. Already You are clean because of the word that I have spoken to you. Abide in Me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit by itself, unless it abides in the VINE, neither can you, unless you abide in Me. I am the VINE; you are the branches. Whoever abides in Me and I in him, he bears much fruit; for apart from Me you can do nothing.” John 15:1–2

DEFINITION OF TRUE: Steadfast, loyal: real, genuine: honest, just, truthful: consistent: legitimate, right: accurate: authentic

DEFINITION OF VINE: The stem or trunk of a plant: a plant whose stem requires support and which climbs by tendrils or twining or creeps along the ground

Jesus, You are the TRUE VINE! You want me to abide—to live in a daily, personal relationship with You! Life flows from You, the VINE, to me, the branch. Jesus, You are my source, my provider, my life! I can do NOTHING of eternal value on my own. I often think I need to do “more” and I wonder if I am doing “enough?” But You have not asked me to “do more”—You have not asked me to “produce” anything on my own! You have only asked me to abide in You—to stay connected to You! Jesus, thank You for being all I need! I worship You as the TRUE VINE!!

Are you abiding in Jesus? Thank Him, praise Him, and worship Him as the TRUE VINE today!!



DAY NINETY-SIX

TRUTH

Thomas said to Him, “Lord, we do not know where You are going. How can we know the way?” Jesus said to him, “I am the way, and the TRUTH, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me.” John 14:5–6

DEFINITION OF TRUTH: The things that are true: fidelity, constancy: sincerity in action, character, and utterance: the quality or state of being true: actuality

DEFINITION OF TRUE: Agreeing with the facts: not false: real or genuine: steadfast, loyal: honest, just: truthful: ideal, essential: consistent: legitimate, rightful: accurate

Jesus, You are TRUTH! You are constancy, sincerity in action, character, and utterance, real, genuine, steadfast, loyal, honest, and accurate! John 1:14 says you are full of “grace and TRUTH.” Jesus, You are all that is TRUE—You are TRUTH itself! The Hebrew Greek Key Study Bible says TRUTH is, “the reality clearly lying before our eyes, as opposed to a mere appearance, without reality.”⁵ Sometimes I place my trust in things of this world that are not true. But Jesus, You are TRUTH—You are exactly who You say You are! How I see You—is who You really are. I can completely TRUST You. I can believe what You say and who You say You are. You are who my hearts longs for! You comfort me by telling me not to “let my heart be troubled!”, but to believe in You. Oh Jesus, I trust You and Your word. Fix my eyes on You, Jesus, and increase my affection for You! You are TRUTH itself and I can trust You! I worship You today for being TRUTH!!

Who are you putting your trust in? Is it Jesus? Thank Him, praise Him, and worship Him as TRUTH today!!



DAY NINETY-SEVEN
UNCHANGABLE

*Jesus Christ is the SAME yesterday and today, yes and forever.
Hebrews 13:8 (NASB)*

DEFINITION OF UNCHANGEABLE: Not able to change or be changed:
immutable

Jesus, You are UNCHANGEABLE! You are always the SAME! You are changeless, stable, steady, constant, established, durable, enduring, and permanent! Oh how my heart longs for things in this world to stay the same; but only in You, Jesus, will I find that security! When I look for it in this world, I am disappointed. But when I look for it in You, I am satisfied and secure! I want to lean into You Jesus! You are the One who is constant, unvarying, ceaseless, settled, established, permanent, and unalterable! As I look to You, I am steady and fortified. You, Jesus, are UNCHANGEABLE!! I want to look to You—the One who is eternally trustworthy! You were the SAME at the beginning of time when You created the world. You were the SAME when You provided a way of salvation. And now You are the SAME as You reign forever in heaven! I can RELY on You to be constant and changeless. I can place my complete trust in You now and forever; because You NEVER CHANGE!! Your love for me stays the SAME now and for all of eternity! I bow down before You King Jesus—You alone are worthy of all my trust and all my worship!! You are UNCHANGEABLE!

Who are you looking to for security? Thank Jesus; praise Him, and worship Him as UNCHANGEABLE today!!



DAY NINETY-EIGHT

WAY

Thomas said to Him, “Lord, we do not know where You are going. How can we know the WAY?” Jesus said to him, “I AM the WAY, and the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me.” John 14:5–6

DEFINITION OF WAY: A thoroughfare for travel or transportation from place to place: an opening for passage: the course traveled from one place to another: route: a course leading in a direction or toward an objective

Jesus, You are the only WAY! This was why You came to earth! You died to prepare a WAY for me to live in eternity with the Father. The only WAY that I can go to the Father is through believing what You, Jesus, did for me on the cross. You took my place—You redeemed me—You were lifted up so that I might believe in You and have a WAY to my Father! “And I, if I be lifted up from the earth, will DRAW all men to Myself” (John 12:32 NASB). WONDERFUL COUNSELOR

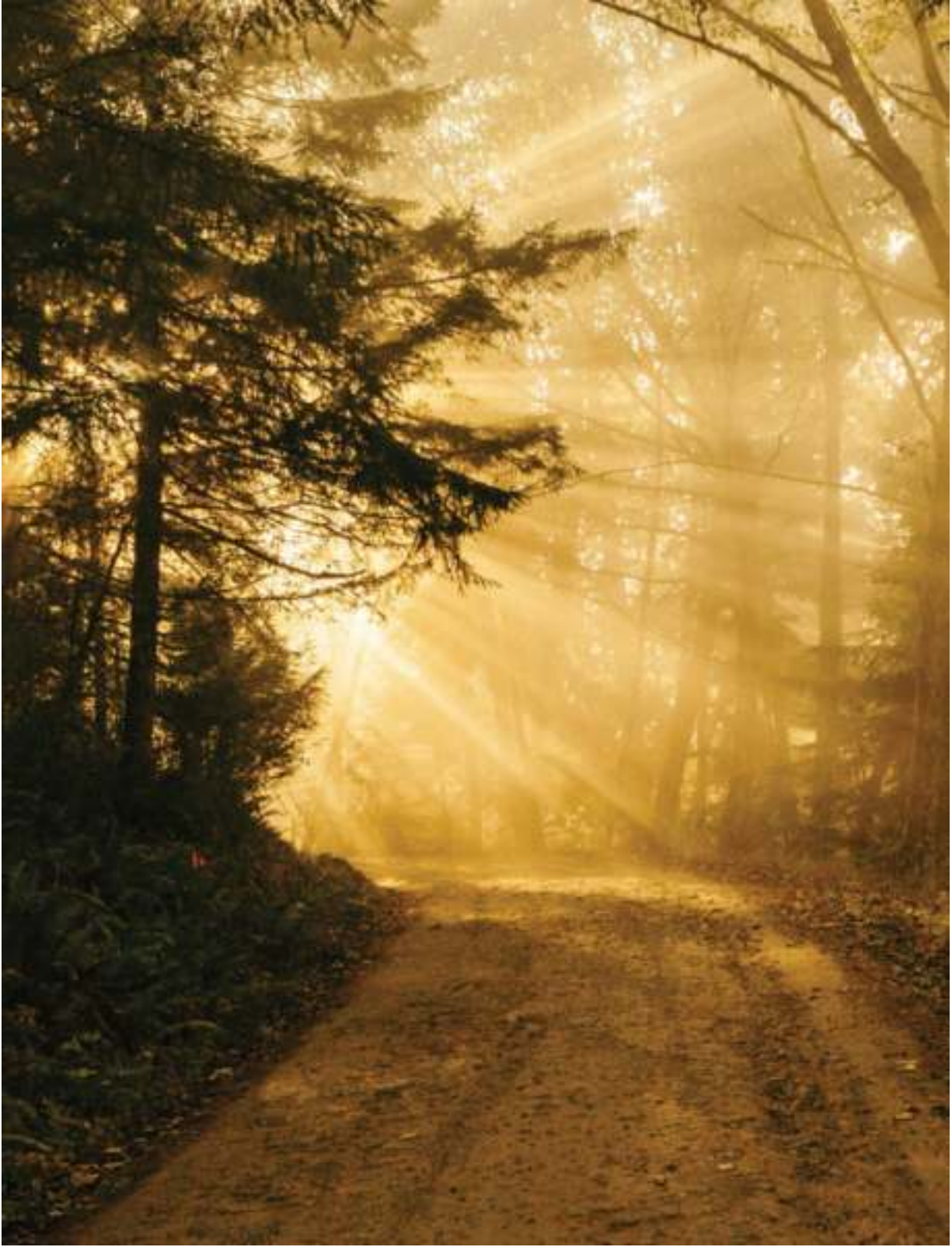

DEFINITION OF **WORD** (LOGOS): The divine wisdom manifest in the creation, government, and redemption of the world and identified as the second person of the Trinity : Jesus
